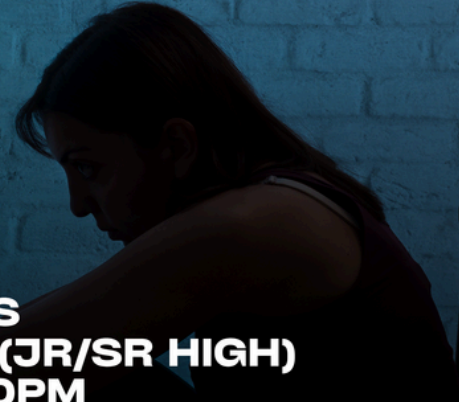

Dr. Dan Cole has served in full-time Christian ministry within the Church of the Nazarene for more than 47 years as a pastor, district superintendent, and ministry leader. Throughout his career, Dan and his wife, Roxanna, have faithfully served congregations across Illinois, Colorado, California, New Mexico, Indiana, and Nebraska.

Dan has provided pastoral leadership in several growing churches, including serving as Lead Pastor of Central Church of the Nazarene in Omaha, Nebraska, beginning in 2008. Prior to that role, he served as Executive Pastor of Crossroads Community Church of the Nazarene in Goshen, Indiana, where he oversaw a twelve-member staff and

provided leadership for the church's financial and operational ministries.

In 2011, Dan was appointed Nebraska District Superintendent by General Superintendent Dr. Stan A. Toler. He served in a dual role as Pastor and Superintendent for several years before becoming the district's full-time superintendent in 2015 at the invitation of the Nebraska District Advisory Board. In November 2021, Dr. Cole returned to a dual role, serving as Lead Pastor of Fremont Church of the Nazarene while continuing his leadership as District Superintendent in Nebraska.

Dr. Cole holds an Associate Degree in Biblical Studies from Nazarene Bible College, a Bachelor of Science in Business and Organizational Management from Indiana Wesleyan University (cum laude), and a Master's degree in Pastoral Leadership from Olivet Nazarene University. In 2021, MidAmerica Nazarene University conferred upon him an honorary Doctor of Divinity degree.

Dan and Roxanna met when Dan preached a revival service at the Church of the Nazarene where Roxanna grew up. They have been married for 47 years and are blessed with four adult children and twelve grandchildren.
