What We Believe

1b) Acts 8:37-39, "Then Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may." And he answered and said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God." So, he commanded the chariot to stand still. And both Philip and the eunuch went _____ the water, and he baptized him. Now when they came _____ the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught Philip away . . ."

2) Matthew 28:19, "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, _____ them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,"

3) Romans 6:3-4, "Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? Therefore, we were _____ with Him through baptism into death that just as Christ was _____ from the dead by the glory of the Father; even so we also should walk in newness of life."

4) Acts 2:41-42, "Then those who gladly _____ his word were _____; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them."

5) Luke 22:14-20, "When the hour had come, He sat down, and the twelve apostles with Him. Then He said to them, "With fervent desire I have desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer; for I say to you, I will no longer eat of it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God." Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, "Take this and divide it among yourselves; for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in _____ of Me." Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you."
