Building Confidence in Prayer

Primary Text: Hebrews 4:14–16

1. THE INVITATION TO BOLDNESS

Hebrews 4:14–16

Jesus is our Great High Priest who understands our weaknesses. Because of Him, we have access to come boldly before God.

Boldly (parrhesia): confidence, freedom, fearless access

2. THE FOUNDATION OF CONFIDENCE — RECONCILIATION

2 Corinthians 5:17–21

You are a new creation. You have been reconciled to God. Your sins are not being counted against you. You are an ambassador for Christ.

3. GOD'S DESIRE TO BLESS YOU

Psalm 37:3–4; Matthew 7:7–8

Trust in the Lord. Delight yourself in Him. Ask, seek, and knock with expectation.

Heart (leb): the inner man, your spirit

4. THE MECHANICS OF BOLD PRAYER

1. TARGET — Mark 11:24

Define what you are asking God for. Be specific and believe you receive.

2. TRUTH — John 17:17; John 8:31–32

Stand on God's Word. Truth removes doubt and produces freedom.

3. CONFESSION — Romans 10:17; 2 Corinthians 4:13

Speak the Word of God. Faith grows as you hear and declare it.

4. AFFIRMING YOUR SPIRIT — Jude 1:20

Build yourself up in faith. Strengthen your spirit through prayer.

5. KEY REMINDERS

God hears you. God accepts you. God responds to faith. God honors His Word.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

1. What am I believing God for?
2. What Scripture supports it?
3. What am I speaking daily?
4. Am I building my spirit consistently?

DECLARATION

I come boldly to God. I am accepted in Christ. I stand on His Word. I speak what He has said. I expect Him to move.
