**1. The Threat (v. 31-33)**

FEAR is a tool of the enemy...

**Herod was concerned about Jesus...*Luke 9:7-9***

**Jesus was NOT concerned about Herod...*Psalm 2:1-4***

***Go tell that fox:***

***I am casting out demons...Healing people...I am not running!***

The Keys to Overcoming Fear:

-Knowing God...Knowing Your Call/Mission

**2 Timothy 1:6-12**

**2. The Tears (v. 34)**

**Jesus Is Grieving...*Jerusalem...Jerusalem***

-Patience of God

-Pleading of Christ...***Mother Hen***

-Protection of Christ...***Psalm 91:4***

-Power of Choice

**3. The Truth (v. 35)**

**Warning:** Rejection has consequences!

Destruction...Desolation

**Hope: "You shall not see Me until the time comes when you say, 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!'"**
