

Important information to know regarding baptisms at Ridgeview Church:

*** Meet with Carl Barnes in the foyer (right in front of the sanctuary) at 11:15 AM. He will go over all the details with you then and give you your baptism certificate.**

* Wear comfortable (dark colored) clothing.

* Feel free to bring a towel with you, but we will have a few on hand if you need one!

* Bring a dry change of clothes with you.

* Be sure to grab a Ridgeview Church baptism t-shirt in your size before leaving the church for the day (shirts are located in tubs in the room to the right of the sanctuary stage as you prepare to enter the baptism tub). If we don't have your size, please email jenni.pritchard@ridgeview.net with the size you need, and we will restock your size as soon as possible.

* If a photographer is available the day of your baptism, we will do our best to take pictures for you and will send you any photos that are taken. Please be sure you have indicated on your form if we have permission to post any of the photos taken on our website and/or social media. Please let us know prior to your baptism if you **do not** want any pictures taken. Once you complete the form to schedule a baptism and receive your confirmation email, please let us know as soon as possible if you see any corrections needed on the spelling of your name (this will be what is printed on your baptism certificate).
