



Read: Luke 19:11-27

Connect Questions:

1. What specific “mina” has God entrusted to you - Gospel, Word, Testimony, Opportunity? Are you using it or hiding it?
2. The third servant had a distorted view of the Master. What is your actual operating picture of God? How does it shape your willingness to take “risks” for Him?
3. If Jesus returned this year, would your life show the fruit of active stewardship or the “handkerchief of passivity”?
4. Do you give God the credit or quietly take it yourself for whatever fruit He’s produced through you?
5. Who in your life could you invest in this week - sharing with, discipling, encouraging, serving? Where are you “playing it safe” relationally where God is calling you to “do business till He comes”?
