1 CARRY ONE ANOTHER

MARK 2:3



The story begins with the faith of his community.

They carried him when he couldn't carry himself.



LESSON LEARNED:

God often uses the strength of others to carry us when we are too weak to carry ourselves.



DO:

Carry someone when they don't have the strength to move themselves.

2 LIFT ONE ANOTHER

MARK 2:4A



When the crowd blocked their way, they lifted him higher.

Sometimes lifting looks like encouragement, advocacy, prayer, or presence.



LESSON LEARNED:

Faith refuses to let obstacles become excuses.



DO:

Lift someone.
Your perspective may be the key to their breakthrough.

3 CREATE SPACE FOR ONE ANOTHER

MARK 2:4B-5



They didn't just open a roof – they created a new space for someone to encounter Jesus.

Community creates space for faith to grow.



LESSON LEARNED:

Healthy community intentionally makes room for people to encounter Jesus.



DO:

Open your home, your schedule, your heart. Create space for Jesus to transform lives.
