1 SAMUEL 3:1-10

“Speak, LORD, for Your servant is listening.”
1 SAMUEL 3:10



REACH UP

- We must wrestle with Religion vs Relationship
- Other people can only take you so far.
- There will come a time where we must know God for ourselves.



REACH IN

- Are we spiritually asleep?
- If so, we must recognize what is causing us to sleep on our calling.
- We must also become comfortable being uncomfortable and stop looking for God's movement in our convenience.



REACH OUT

- The older generation must equip the younger.
- Let us never fail to teach those who are coming after us, even if we will not be in that next chapter.



REACH FORWARD

- We must adjust our posture to hear the call, respond to the call, and live out the call.
- God is calling. Will we walk in that calling or sleep through it?

1 EMBRACE HOLY DISRUPTIONS



GOD WAKES US UP

1 Samuel 3:3-4

- God breaks through our natural sleep to awaken our spirit.
- Divine encounters are not convenient or comfortable.
- Restlessness in our routine may be a wake-up call.
- Hope: God is waking us up for a season of transition.

2 AVOID HUMAN DISTRACTIONS



WE RUN, BUT NOT IN ALIGNMENT

1 Samuel 3:5-6

- We often run to the wrong source for validation.
- Motion does not equal momentum.
- Even when we miss it, God keeps calling.
- Hope: God gives second chances and keeps speaking.

3 FOLLOW HEAVENLY DIRECTIONS



HEAVEN COMES CLOSE

1 Samuel 3:9-10

- Responding requires a posture of prophetic surrender.
- God comes near when we make our hearts available.
- He calls us by name with love and urgency.
- Hope: Be positioned to receive Him and live out the call.

KEY TAKEAWAY



God is always speaking, but we must make space to hear, recognize His voice, and respond in obedient faith.
