1. Pray for safety as our group travels to and from camp and throughout every activity during the week.

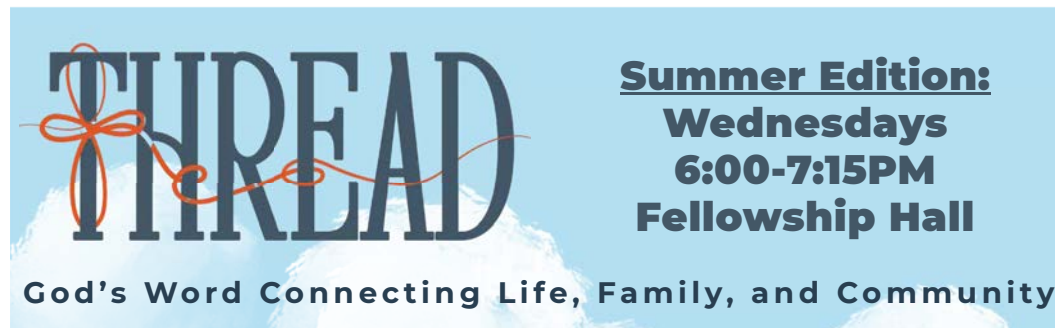
