A New Legacy Begins at CrossTimbers

Three years after coming to faith in Christ, Amanda Nunez will attend CrossTimbers for the first time as a sponsor alongside her daughter, Nani, who will be attending as a first-time camper. Together, they're experiencing more than a week at camp. They're celebrating the beginning of a new family legacy.

Just a few years ago, Amanda Nunez never imagined she would be preparing for a week of Christian camp.

"I didn't grow up in a Christian family," she said. "I went to church with friends growing up, but I never stayed very long or ever felt like I belonged. I thought I was too broken and lost to be there."

For years, church felt like a place where she didn't belong. But after the loss of her grandfather, grief became the catalyst that drew her toward Christ.

"I remember being so angry at God," Amanda recalled. "I never thought that anger would lead me to church, but it did. I was so incredibly mad and sad, and through all of those emotions I felt the Holy Spirit. I knew the only way I could heal was to let God do it."

Since surrendering her life to Christ, Amanda says God has changed "literally everything." One of the greatest joys has been sharing her faith with her husband Raymond and their three children.

"I love reading the Bible with my family. The greatest joy is not only praying over them, but with them."

Today, Amanda and Raymond serve in Extended Session, and their daughter Nani has already begun volunteering alongside them. Nani is already looking forward to the day she is old enough to serve during Vacation Bible School.

This summer marks another milestone as Amanda and Nani travel together to CrossTimbers for the first time. Amanda will serve as a sponsor while Nani experiences camp as a camper.

"It's both of our first times," Nani said. "We can go on a journey together."

Although Amanda's faith journey is still relatively new, Nani already sees its impact. When asked how her mom and dad helps her grow closer to Jesus, Nani answered, "By bringing us to church and praising the Lord."

As they prepare for camp, Amanda's prayer is that Nani experiences the presence of the Holy Spirit, grows stronger in her faith, and forms friendships that will encourage her walk with Christ. Nani's prayer for her mom is much simpler. "That she has fun."

Amanda hopes that years from now, her daughter remembers more than fun, games, and outdoor adventures. "I hope she remembers that her momma was right there with her, loving God and worshiping Him alongside her," Amanda said. "That I was praying for her every step of the way."

Looking back, Amanda says she never could have imagined this chapter of her life. Yet today, a mother who once believed she was too broken for church is preparing to invest in the faith of not only her own daughter, but an entire cabin of young campers.

For the Nunez duo, CrossTimbers represents more than a week at camp. It is another step in a story of God's redeeming work, one that is already being passed from one generation to the next.
