Falls Creek Youth Camp

From Camper to Calling

One Falls Creek experience sparked a relationship that helped shape a future in ministry.

For many students, Falls Creek is a week filled with worship, laughter, friendships, and unforgettable memories. For Dylan Stites, it became the beginning of a lifelong journey of discipleship.

Although he doesn't remember every detail from his first trip to Falls Creek with FBC Lawton, Dylan remembers something even more important.

"The environment made by the other students and adults made me feel welcomed and wanted," he said.

After making the decision to follow Christ before his sophomore year of high school at Falls Creek, Dylan knew he wanted to grow in his faith. Without a family that could encourage him spiritually, he looked to the older students, sponsors, and church leaders who invested in the lives of teenagers.

In 2019, that investment became personal.

When Aaron Myers connected Dylan with Scott Kochenower, the two began meeting regularly to study the book of John. What started as Sunday morning Bible studies grew into years of intentional discipleship.

"Scott was the first person to invest in me outside of camp and church," Dylan shared. *"He never made me feel like I was a burden when I came to him with questions. His transparency and willingness to walk alongside me are qualities I hope to carry into ministry."*

Scott quickly recognized God was doing something special.

"He was just 15 and owning his faith," Scott said. *"He was getting himself up for church, diving into Scripture, asking hard questions, and pursuing Christ despite many obstacles."*

As the years passed, Dylan began sensing God's call to ministry. Today, after graduating from Oklahoma State University, he is serving as a student ministry intern at FBC Lawton while pursuing a future in youth ministry.

For Scott, watching that journey unfold has been an answer to prayer.

"We've prayed over him for the past seven years," Scott said. *"It's been amazing watching those prayers answered before our eyes."*

Reflecting on his own experience, Scott believes discipleship is something every believer should embrace.

"We all need to be a Paul and a Timothy at some point," he said. *"It's a command from Christ, and it will bless you in ways you can't imagine."*

As another generation of students heads to Falls Creek this summer, Dylan hopes they'll arrive with open hearts.

"Have an open mind, listen intentionally, and have a lot of fun," he said.

Sometimes, God uses one week at camp to begin a story that lasts a lifetime.

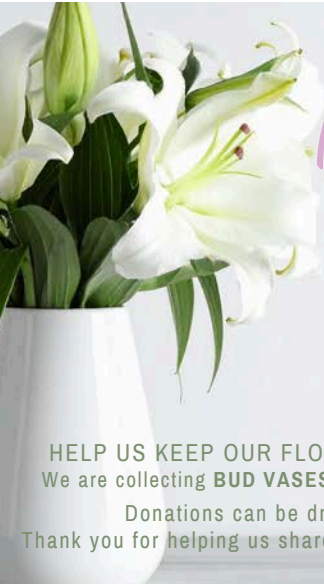

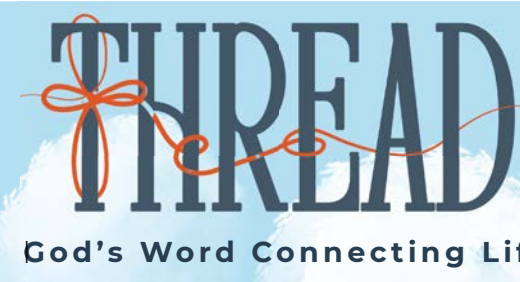
The Experience

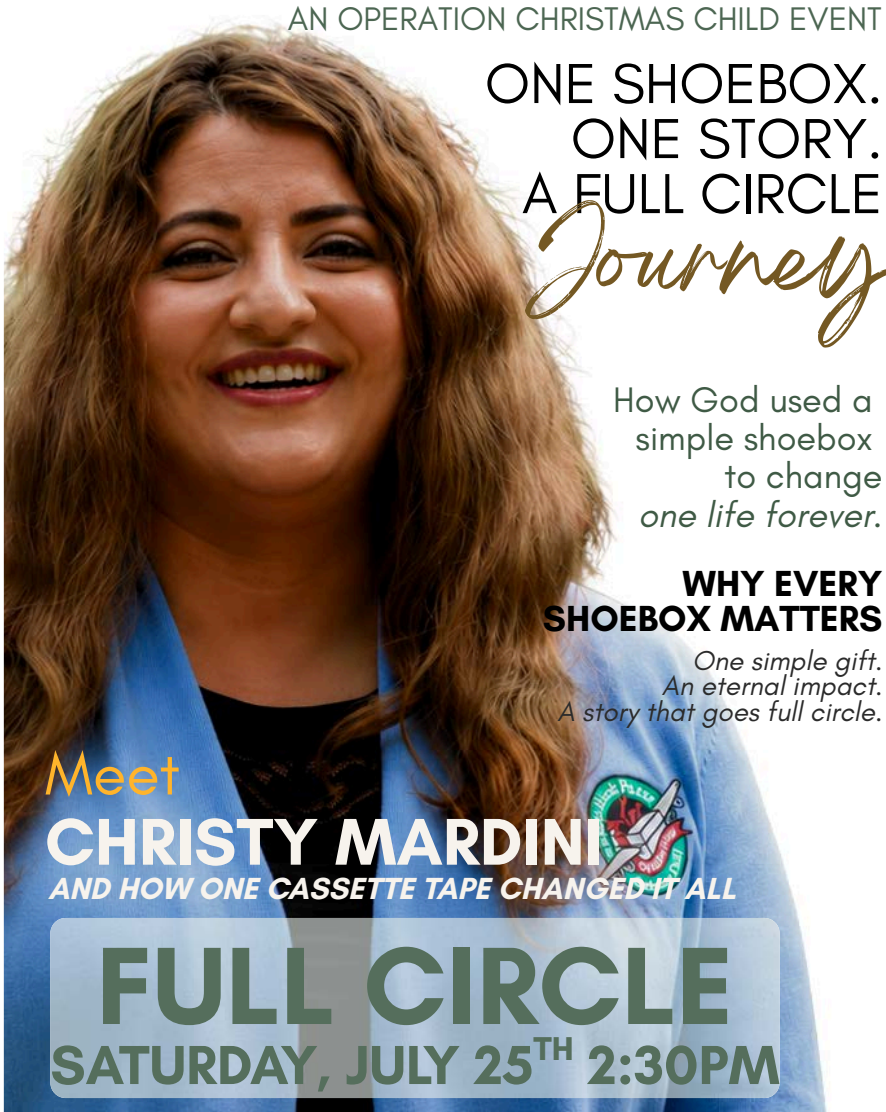
