Every Drop Carries Hope

The Lenamond family's story reminds us that one blood donation can change someone's future.

When the Lenamond family learned they were expecting quadruplets, they knew life would be anything but ordinary.

Their four babies arrived prematurely, each facing an uncertain future. During their time in the neonatal intensive care unit (NICU), all four babies required blood transfusions. One of the surviving boys also needed platelet donations, receiving more blood products than anyone could have imagined.

Despite the incredible care they received, two of the Lenamond quads passed away. Their son and daughter survived, thanks in part to the generosity of blood donors they will likely never meet.

For the Lenamond family, donated blood wasn't just a medical treatment. It was time. Time for doctors to care for fragile babies. Time for hope to grow. Time that ultimately helped save two precious lives.

Stories like theirs remind us that every blood donation matters.

On **Sunday, August 30**, FBC Lawton is partnering with Our Blood Institute to host a community blood drive. Whether you're a first-time donor or have donated for years, your willingness to give could become part of another family's story of hope.

Blood cannot be manufactured. Platelets cannot be created in a laboratory. They come only from people who choose to give.

You'll probably never meet the person whose life is changed by your donation. You may never know their name or hear their story. But somewhere, another family may be praying for the very gift you have the opportunity to provide.
