Feature Story

This year, two women answered God's call again.

When FBC Lawton's Roatan Mission Team returns to Honduras this year, Sharon Powers and Michelle Pickett will once again be among those serving. Though their stories are different, they share one thing in common: a willingness to answer God's call again.

For Sharon, missions has been part of her life since childhood. After trusting Christ at a young age, she began serving on mission as a teenager. Life didn't always follow the path she expected, but God remained faithful.

"I wasted some time following my own dreams," Sharon shared. "But God continued loving me and gave me new opportunities to obey Him and go on missions."

Michelle's journey started with what she describes as "a little spark of interest" and the Lord opening doors. While there wasn't one defining moment, she believes every Christian is called to share the Gospel, whether with a neighbor across the street or someone across the world.

Both women know obedience isn't always easy. It often requires sacrificing comfort, time, finances, or certainty. Yet both have discovered that God's faithfulness is greater than every obstacle.

One of Michelle's favorite memories from last year's trip was watching her son walk alongside a Honduran boy his own age, carrying buckets of water home for his family. "Through prayers, through a walk to get water, through simple service, Christ draws people to Himself."

For Sharon, one unforgettable encounter was meeting a young man who had been shot and left paralyzed. His circumstances were difficult, but his story was ultimately one of hope.

"But God... He was saved, forgiven, and given hope."

Now they're preparing to return. Sharon is looking forward to serving through health clinics and childcare, while Michelle is praying God will continue raising up the next generation of mission-minded leaders.

Neither woman claims to have all the answers. They have simply learned that when God calls, obedience is always worth it. This year, they'll board another plane and serve another community.

Not because they have to. Because God called. Again.
And once again, they answered.
