From our Associate Pastor

On Monday, April 24th at 6:00pm, the Session of Bethany Church had a special meeting to hear the Statements of Faith from the 4 Confirmation students. They read their statements in front of the session, family members, and the mentors. They were officially welcomed as members of Bethany Church on Sunday, April 30th.

The Confirmation Program at Bethany Church is about teaching, mentoring, and loving these students as they prepare to become members of the church and claim their faith as their own. The curriculum we use is called Big God, Big Questions, and through a series of 12 classes, the confirmands are equipped with the vital skills of asking and seeking answers using scripture, tradition, and the church to tell their own story as Christian believers.

As part of this Confirmation program and evidence of their own growth, we require each student to write a Faith Statement -- a one page statement, including sentences about: what you believe about God; what you believe about Jesus; what you believe about the Holy Spirit; and what you believe about the Church (not just Bethany, but the universal church). They are also asked to include why these things matter to them personally.

I encourage members of Bethany to consider these questions of faith as well. I am sure your Faith Statement in 8th grade is different now, no matter your age. Maybe we can all be inspired to revisit these basic questions about what we believe and why what we believe matters.

Congratulations to our Confirmation Students and thank you to everyone who was involved in this year's program.


