Join us in welcoming **our new Associate Pastor - Pastor Justin Miller!** Pastor Justin will be starting his time here at Bethany Presbyterian Church on **October 1st, 2026**. Pastor Justin has been faithfully serving in pastoral ministry preaching the word of God, caring for the people of God, and helping to cultivate a vibrant, Christ-centered community in his congregation in Ohio. Pastor Justin's preparation for ministry includes both solid academic training and years of practical experience in the local church. He holds a Master of Divinity from Emmanuel Christian Seminary, and he completed his undergraduate studies at Johnson University, where he double majored in Preaching & Youth Ministry and Bible and Theology. This combination of theological study and ministry-focused training has shaped his heart and mind for pastoral work, biblical teaching, and shepherding God's people.

In his ministry, Justin has engaged in regular preaching and teaching, leading small groups and Bible studies, discipling youth and adults, and walking alongside individuals and families through both joyful and challenging seasons. MUSIC NOTES FROM NADINA



Most families know this as the "Back to School" season, and for my household, it means schedules, routines, and goal setting are back to our regular! Although we miss the more relaxed schedule that summer provides, these routines give us a sense of direction. Working in the church for so many years, I know that our Liturgical calendar also puts us back on track in these ways, too. Our "regular" worship times resume; music ministry groups resume; routines develop for liturgy needs- changing paraments, filling binders, rehearsal upon rehearsal, warm ups, prayer requests in the hallways.... Getting back into the liturgical season gives us all direction....leading us to journey to the stable, to the path of Discipleship, following the Lord to the cross, and celebrating the victory of life eternal in His resurrection is a wonderful schedule for us to celebrate as a community.

This fall and Advent/Christmas season, I was inspired to follow a nudge in the direction of a new choral composition that I came across in the (favorite) part of the summer in which I get to explore anthems.

Joanna Forbes Lestrange created a choral work that is based on Vivaldi's The Four Seasons. It was written to celebrate it's 300 year anniversary, but in an entirely different setting than he originally composed it. The choir will feature a few of her anthems from this incredible composition, as she set several of the melodies to lyrics of Scripture. I'm sure many of you will recognize and enjoying hearing how God's Word found a part in this composition! Enjoying the theme of the seasons, finding direction in liturgy and calendars, and seeing how God's Word continues to find new ways to emerge, the choir will also share a new Cantata this season. I kept with the theme of Vivaldi, and our new Cantata features an anthem based on his Gloria. The choir has done the incredible Gloria in the past as it is in our files, so many of you will already recognize this glorious piece! I know that we've all enjoyed hearing the themes that Pastor Brian presents in his sermon series, we've enjoyed looking for the little Jesus' that the youth hide around the church, the "pop-up" events that we all appreciated this summer, and I hope you will be blessed to see and hear how Vivaldi's works will "pop up" on some occasions in our worship services to enhance our experience of how God continues to direct us through the seasons, in new and inspiring ways like this!

The choir, chimes, ukuleles, and all Children's Music ministries invite and WELCOME any new attendees with open arms! Please know that you are free to join us to try any of these ensembles- without an obligation to commit!

The choir will start a NEW and ADDITIONAL practice offering this season with hopes to give an alternate time for folks that can't make a Wednesday night schedule work. We will work on vocal exerisies/warm ups and work on the anthem for the upcoming Sundays. Please check the bulletin for the times and dates for all of our ensemble offerings that resume. BETHANY CHILDREN OF GOD

The discipleship team is thrilled to announce a new program for older children during the 10:45 worship service. "Faith & Friends" is a class offered to children in grades 3-5 which will run concurrently with the existing Worship & Wonder. Together, the two classes, along with the existing Sunday School offerings which comprise our Children's Ministry will be referred to as Bethany's Children of God.

Please note: parents may choose to keep children of any age with them in the church service!

Parents who choose to send their children to classes will sign the children in at the kiosk for Sunday School, Worship & Wonder, and Faith & Friends using the last 4 digits of their phone number. A name tag will be printed for the children, and the parents will receive a corresponding label. This process will serve as both security at pick up time for new families as well as a record of attendance.

CHILDREN'S WORSHIP DURING THE 10:45AM SERVICE

Nursery Care

Any child under the age of 3 adjacent to the Sanctuary Nursery care is available for babies & toddlers during both the 8:15 & 10:45 services as well as during the Sunday School hour.

Worship & Wonder – Age 3 through 2nd grade in Room 234

Worship and Wonder is a special class where young children learn to worship God and learn more about Him. If it is your child's first experience with a Sunday school class, you are welcome to stay with them. This year we will be starting with the story about the Good Shepherd and then continue into the stories of Creation and the Old Testament.

Faith & Friends – 3rd through 5th grade in Room 239

Faith and Friends is designed for older children who are not yet ready to stay for the entire church service. This class will explore lessons from the Bible In Life Curriculum by David C Cook. Through interactive learning, meaningful discussion, and hands-on activities, children are encouraged to grow in their understanding of Scripture and their relationship with God. While the scripture lesson will be the same for both Sunday School and Faith & Friends each week, the lesson content and activities will be different.

All Grades 1-12 will be using Bible In Life Curriculum by David C Cook

This comprehensive curriculum provides engaging, age-appropriate lessons that help students discover Biblical truths and apply them to everyday life. Through interactive learning, meaningful discussion, and hands-on activities, children are encouraged to grow in their understanding of Scripture and their relationship with God.

Grades 4-7 will meet in Room 240 with rotating teachers: Kara Julius, Ashley Strouse, & Sara Sunderlin

Women Of The Bible- In Fellowship Hall

Devin Underwood, assisted by Sharon Salvini, will be finishing up last year's study of James for the first three classes. Beginning in October, the class will work together to choose one Woman Of The Bible to study each month. This class is intended for adult men & women.

Through the Bible - In the Bethany Room

Doug Bovard leads this class. We will read through the Bible at home, in class and discuss. Reading through the Bible is the most transformative, intellectual, spiritual, and personal project a human can take on. Know that scripture is practical not abstract. It speaks to anxiety, suffering, temptation, forgiveness... Rather than reading fragmented bits and pieces of scripture, reading through the Bible will immerse us in the whole counsel of God (Acts 20:27). The Bible gives God's identity, our identity, and his plan for salvation. Meet God on his terms – not ours! Do away with the influence of current culture! Recalibrate your heart and mind to God's eternal truth! Let's Read the Bible! This class is for anyone over 21 years of age.

Women's Sunday School Class - In Room 224

Becky Yanak will be leading a 12 week video study entitled; Rahab, Hagar, and Naomi. "How does everyone else see me? How do I see myself? How does God see me? These women in the Bible asked the same three questions we still ask today. In this video study you'll see how the stories of Rahab, Hagar and Naomi reflect our own lives and what we can learn about ourselves from them. Throughout the study, these women step out of the pages of scripture to walk with you through your own story with powerful teachings." All women are welcomed, even if you have never attended Sunday School Class in the past.

2 Corinthians - In the Chapel

Mark Rackley will be finishing up last year's study of second Corinthians, picking up at chapter 12 which is expected to take about one month. In the first class of the year (September 13 th) the class will discuss together and determine their next topic of study. This class is intended for adult men & women.

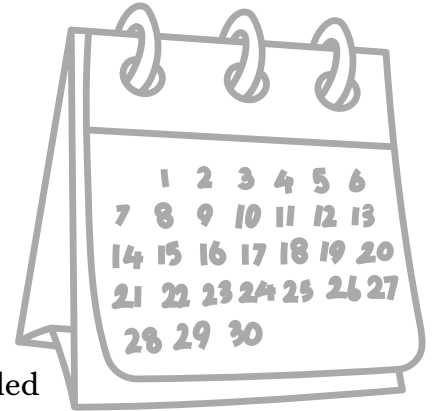
