

❖ **The Text** **Ephesians 1:4-14**

A. Grace Defined – the free unmerited love and favor of God.

1. God’s eternal plan in Christ was to be extremely _____ to believers in Christ.
 - **Ephesians 1:5** – ... by Jesus Christ to himself, **according to the good pleasure of his will,**
 - **Ephesians 1:6** – To the praise of **the glory of his grace,** wherein he hath made us...
 - **Ephesians 1:7** – ... the forgiveness of sins, **according to the riches of his grace;**
 - **Ephesians 1:8** – Wherein **he hath abounded toward us** in all wisdom and prudence;
 - **Ephesians 1:9** – ... **according to the good pleasure** which he hath purposed in himself:
 - **Ephesians 1:12** – That we should be **to the praise of his glory...**
 - God takes good pleasure in giving us all spiritual blessings in Jesus Christ!
 - He has chosen to share His limitless riches and wisdom with us!

2. God’s eternal plan was made possible only because of the _____ of Jesus Christ.
 - **2 Corinthians 8:9** – For ye know **the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ,** that, though he was rich, **YET FOR YOUR SAKES HE BECAME POOR,** that ye through his poverty might be rich.
 - **Romans 5:8, 20** – But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, **WHILE WE WERE YET SINNERS,** Christ died for us... **But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound...**
 - It is the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ that has made this truth possible for us!

3. Grace **brought us** NEAR.

- He _____ us to be with Him. **1:4** – ... without blame **before him in love**
 ✓ **Heb 4:16** – Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace...
- He _____ us into His family. **1:5** – ... unto the **adoption** of children
 ✓ **Rom 8:15** – ... the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.
- He _____ us in the beloved. **1:6** – ... made us **accepted** in the beloved
 ✓ **Song 2:16** – My beloved is mine, and I am his...

4. Grace **bought us** FREE.

- He _____ us by His blood. **1:7** – ... have **redemption** through his blood
 ✓ **Heb 9:12** – ... but by his own blood... having obtained eternal redemption for us.
- He _____ us of all our sins. **1:7** – ... the **forgiveness** of sins
 ✓ **Coloss 2:14** – Blotting out the handwriting... against us... nailing it to his cross;

 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish or spot:

5. Grace **blessed us** FOREVER.

- He _____ His will to us. **1:9** – ... made **known** ... mystery of his will
 ✓ **2 Pet 1:3-4** – ... hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness...
- He gave us an _____. **1:11** – ... we have **obtained an inheritance**
 ✓ **Rom 8:17** – And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint heirs with Christ...
- He _____ us in His purpose. **1:11** – ... **according to the purpose** of him
 ✓ **2 Tim 1:9** – Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling...
- He made us a _____ of His glory. **1:12** – ... **be to the praise of his glory**
 ✓ **Eph 2:7** – ... in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace

C. Grace Secured – the promise is to all who believe on the Lord Jesus Christ!

6. Grace **seals us** SECURELY.

- His grace must be _____.
 ✓ **Ephesians 1:13** – In whom ye also TRUSTED, after that ye HEARD the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye BELIEVED, ye were SEALED with that holy Spirit of promise.
- His grace can _____ settle your eternal salvation.
 ✓ **Ephesians 1:14** – Which is the earnest of our inheritance UNTIL the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of HIS GLORY.

W1828: “earnest”
 Guarantee of full completion; that which is given in advance and gives promise of something to come.

John 10:28-29
 ... neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand... my Father’s hand.

“... ye were SEALED with that holy Spirit of promise...”

In Paul’s time, the seal meant ownership, authenticity, protection, and authority. A king’s seal meant: “This belongs to me. No unauthorized hand may alter it.”
