
2025 ANNUAL REPORT

BRIDGE OF HOPE

Bridge of Hope is a ministry partnership between Hill Country Daily Bread and The Bridge that meets every Thursday to serve vulnerable local families. In 2025 alone, Bridge of Hope delivered over 400 food boxes plus essential supplies (coats, meals, gifts) to 20 families.

Since the ministry began in July 2024, they have expanded from serving 10 to 18 families, seeing 2 graduations from the program.
