

Thyatira (Background)

- 1. This is the only church Jesus addresses as the Son of God Jesus' IDENTITY matters! (Matthew 8:29, 14;33, 16:13-17; John 20:31; 1 John 5:12; Exodus 20:3; Acts 4:12)
- 2. 'Eyes like a flame and feet like bronze' speak of strength, PURITY, JUDGMENT, and perfect vision. (Revelation 1:15, 2:13; Hebrews 4:13, 12:29; Proverbs 5:21; John 5:22,27,30, 9:39; 2 Corinthians 5:10; Acts 10:42; John 1:48; Proverbs 15:3; Luke 8:17; Jeremiah 23;24)

The COMMENDATION

3. At a glance, the church in Thyatira is the church you would WANT TO JOIN - and that is commendable! (1 Thessalonians 1:3; 1 John 4:11; John 15:17; Matthew 20:26-28; Galatians 6:2,10; Ephesians 1:15)

The CENSURE

- 4. Allowing someone to TEACH what is false and to exercise immoral INFLUENCE over the believers is something God will not tolerate nor should we. (1 Kings 16-21; 2 Kings 9:30-37; Romans 1:32; Ephesians 5:11; James 4:17; 1 Corinthians 5:11; 1 Timothy 5:20; John 10:11; 1 Peter 5:1-3; Acts 20:28; Matthew 7:15)
- 5. Love does NOT equal unconditional AFFIRMATION. (Romans 1:32, 12:9; Galatians 6:1; Proverbs 12:1; Matthew 18:15-20; 1 Corinthians 5:1-2)

The CHALLENGE

- 6. For those on the wrong road, repent of what you are DOING, and DO something different! (Psalm 41:13; Isaiah 55:6-7; Jeremiah 26:3; Joel 2:13; Matthew 3:8; Acts 3:19)
- 7. For those on the right road, CLING TIGHTLY to what you have in Christ! (1 Chronicles 16:11; Romans 5:3-5; Philippians 3:13-14; Galatians 6:9; Hebrews 3:14, 12:2; James 1:2-4)

The CONSEQUENCE

- 8. For those on the wrong road, great AFFLICTION (even death) can come as a result of sin. (Acts 5:1-10; 1 John 5:16; 1 Corinthians 11:28-32; Proverbs 10:17, 13:1, 15:10; Hebrews 12:10-11; Luke 13:3; Deuteronomy 8:5-6; Romans 2:4-5; Romans 2:6-8; Matthew 16:27)
- 9. For those on the right road, they will be given AUTHORITY to rule and the gift of being in the eternal presence of JESUS.
