



What is Resurrection Power and how do we receive it?

What does Resurrection Power enable us to do?

1. We are empowered to **SEE** things we have never seen, **UNDERSTAND** what we thought was complete mystery, and **GROW** in ways we never imagined! (Luke 24:29; Acts 1:8; Ephesians 1:16-20, 3:1-6; Colossians 1:26-27; 1 Corinthians 1:18, 2:9-10,14, 4:1; Daniel 2:47; Matthew 13:11; Isaiah 11:2)
2. We are empowered to say “**NO!**” to things that would ruin us (and those around us) and live a **NEW LIFE!** (1 Corinthians 10:13; Galatians 5:16; 1 John 4:4; 2 Corinthians 13:7; 2 Timothy 1:7; Titus 2:11-12; Romans 6:3-4, 8:13)
3. We are empowered to venture beyond the **SHALLOWS** and have an **ABUNDANT** life! (John 10:10, 14:16,26; Romans 15:13; Luke 5:4; Ephesians 3:20; Psalm 23:5; 2 Corinthians 9:8; 2 Peter 1:3; Philippians 4:19)
4. We are empowered to care about those who are **DROWNING** and to throw them a **LIFE RING!** (Acts 1:8; Romans 1:16, 9:1-3; Matthew 9:36-37, 28:19-20; John 15:8; 1 Corinthians 2:1-5)
5. We will **RISE** from the **GRAVE!** (John 11:25-26; 1 Thessalonians 4:16; Romans 6:5, 8:11; 1 Corinthians 15:19-22; Philippians 3:20-21)

7. When is the last time you spent some time contemplating the reality that you will live forever with Christ? (That regardless of what happens on this earth, you will be WITH JESUS forever!!)? (Perhaps spend some time talking about this...and see how your perspective on some things just might change.)
