1. You play a role in the Great Commission through **prayer**, sharing the **Good News**, and **supporting others** who go where you cannot. (Matthew 28:18-20, Acts 13:49, Philippians 1:5, Romans 10:15, 1 Corinthians 9:13-18, Luke 9:6, Romans 15:20, Acts 8:4, Matthew 9:31)
2. The most **unreached** people group in the world is the **Deaf**.
(Romans 15:20-21, Matthew 24:14, Mark 16:15)
3. Most people at some time in their **life** have had a **Heart Wound**.
(Jeremiah 29:11, Philippians 4:6-7, Matthew 11:28, Revelation 21:4, 2 Corinthians 4:8-10, Psalm 71:20, Psalm 147:3, John 14:27, Isaiah 41:10, Psalm 34:18, Psalm 55:22, Hebrews 13:5-6)
4. Jesus wants us to bring our **pain** to the **cross**.
(Matthew 8:17, Psalm 34:18, Psalm 23:1-6, 2 Corinthians 1:3-8, Romans 8:18-28)
5. Jesus's healing of heart wounds not only brings **healing** and **forgiveness**, but it **transforms** people's lives giving them a **desire** to read **God's Word**.
(Luke 8:2, Luke 5:1-11)
