2 Cor. 7: 1-7

God’s Provision for the Pilgrim

June 7, Sun

Prov 3: 9-10

Let’s worship God with freedom and in unity!

“Honor the LORD with your wealth ... then your barns will be filled with plenty and your vats will be bursting with wine.”

June 8, Mon

2 Cor 9: 1-5

Pray for our Senior Citizens – have you reached out to them?

[cf. 8: 1-7] Having made a promise to give, Paul is making sure they are going to deliver the give. Do you make promises to God, to others, and then not acted on it? Read Eccl. 5: 4-5

June 9, Tues

2 Cor 9: 6-15

Pray for the children – have you tried engaging with them?

There are 9 points / principles on giving and God in vs 6-12 – what are they? Write it down and bring it with you next Sunday

June 10, Wed

2 Cor. 10: 1-6

Pray for the newer attendees – have you greeted them?

How can a man, like Paul self-declare ‘I am meek, gentle and humble’ (vs 1). Can someone say that of themselves? Wouldn’t that be pride? We have discussed “flesh” vs “spirit”; hence in vs 4f the “warfare” and its field is explained

June 11, Thur

2 Cor. 10: 7-11

Pray for those ... familiar with – how well do you know them?

In the church in Corinth, there was a defiance of Paul and his authority. So, Paul makes the argument ‘if you are confident that you are in Christ, I am too’. The authority and boldness that comes through in Pauls’ letters, emails and texts appear “frightening” (vs 9), but that authority is for “building” people and the Church (vs 8)

June 12, Fri

2 Cor. 10: 12-18

Birthday: Jeremiah Browne

Paul is perceived as one who brags and boasts – he says that it is true, BUT specifically says what that boast is about – Paul & Co were the first to reach them with the Gospel, and he hopes that more people and areas will be reached. Pay attention to vs 17-18 – good teaching! Is the Lord commending you?

June 13, Sat

2 Cor. 11: 1-6

Pray for your neighbors / friends – pray for them by name

Paul is upset and hurt that the very ones he introduced to Christ are now attacking and demeaning him. So he defends himself in vs 6. He is also trying to show his adversaries that they are being deceived ... just like what happened in the Garden.

June 14, Sun

Prov 3: 13-20
