## *From Mortal to Immortality!*

### May 10, Sun

Prov 2: 2

#### **Worship the risen Savior!**

“make your ear attentive to wisdom ... incline your heart to understanding”

### May 11, Mon

I Cor 16: 1-8

#### **Pray discerningly and ask yourself – am I generous giver?**

A reminder on giving – ‘on the first day of the week, as you prosper’. How is your giving? Has it increased as you prosper?

### May 12, Tues

I Cor 16: 9-16

#### **The Search Comm. Interviews have started – pray!**

In vs 9, two realities of ministry are shown – God opens a “wide door” and there can be “many adversaries”. Because of Timothy’s young age (cf. I Tim 4: 12), Paul encourages the Church to ‘put him at ease ... help him’ – the word of an older man/woman in the life of someone younger goes a long way

### May 13, Wed

I Cor. 16: 17-24

#### **Birthday: Dan Naylor; Anniv.: Karla & Rich Sooby**

Similarly with others, Paul is introducing and building bridges of relationship between people in the family of God. He ends this letter with an exchanged of love and greetings.

### May 14, Thur

2 Cor. 1: 1-7

#### **Pray and invite for the Veteran’s Appreciation Event (30<sup>th</sup>)**

A great passage on suffering and God’s comfort – God will comfort us but that is not the end; we are to comfort others with the same comfort experience we received.

### May 15, Fri

2 Cor. 1: 8-14

#### **Birthday: Angel Granda**

Paul describes his suffering experience – it was frightening, but it taught him not to rely on himself but God. He asks for prayer – do you ask for prayers for those things that you struggle with? A good yardstick for Christian living – vs 12: Paul lived and behaved in the world with “simplicity and godly sincerity”.

### May 16, Sat

2 Cor. 1: 15-24

#### **Pray for the Worship on the Mound Service!**

[written one year after 1<sup>st</sup> Cor., by this time there is open rebellion against Paul] Just as Jesus’ 2<sup>nd</sup> coming includes judgement and hence the grace of delay, Paul states that he changed his mind on a second visit – an act of grace (vs 15, 23)

### May 17, Sun

Prov 2: 10-15

I Cor. 15: 12-58

“If Christ has not been raised ...”
