International Students:

- Tuition and Fees - \$6,100

Note: International Student Tuition and fees includes admission& processing fees, books, activity fees, ESL, tutoring and program administration. A discount will be provided for J-1 students. Host family fees range from \$5,000 – 6,500.

General Fees:

1. A **Registration Fee of \$25** per new family is required upon applying for admission to FBCS. Should the application be denied, the \$25 fee will be refunded.
2. A non-refundable **Activity Fee of \$125** (K-6th grade) or **\$200** (7th - 12th grade) is to be paid with the Early Tuition Payment (ETP) or added to your FACTS agreement. This fee offsets costs for sports; field trips; programs; Fine Arts; student activities, technology, and sports equipment; gym rental; and KCEA membership.
3. A non-refundable **Book Fee of \$175** is to be paid with the Early Tuition Payment (ETP) or added to your FACTS agreement. This fee offsets the cost of textbooks and other curriculum.
4. Homeschool students who participate in sports or Fine Arts must pay a **Homeschool Activity Fee (\$200 for 7th - 12th Grade Programs; \$125 for K5 - 6th Grade Programs)**. This fee covers all sports and Fine Arts and must be paid prior to participation.

Discounts:

1. A 2.5% tuition discount is available to returning students who **pay in full** their tuition and Activity Fee **by July 15th**. New students may receive the discount if they **pay in full upon their acceptance** to the school until November 30th. No discount is given on the Activity Fee or Book Fee.
2. Parents can receive a discount off their tuition for each **new student recruited** to the school. The new student must come from a new family, and the discount will be 10% of the total tuition received for each new student for the first year. There is no limit to how many new students a family may receive credit. This credit will be applied after the final payment is received from the new family, and will be prorated if the student(s) begins school late in the year or leaves the school early.
3. FBCS provides a 30% tuition discount for children of **full-time pastors**.
4. FBCS provides a 10% tuition discount for children of **FBCS graduates**.
5. There is no tuition discount for students attending **Vo-Tech School** in the afternoon.
6. If **textbooks** are brought to school from a homeschooling situation that correspond with the student's class textbooks, parents will receive a prorated credit to their account for the textbooks.
7. There is no proration of tuition for the **third child or more** unless the student(s) comes so late in the year that the first child prorated fee is lower than the full amount of the third or more child(ren) fee. The third or more child(ren) will then be prorated at the first child daily rate.

Payment Schedule:

1. **FACTS Business Solutions** handle all tuition collection except Early Tuition Payments. FACTS automatically deducts monthly tuition from a specified bank account. Tuition is collected over a 10-month period (no collection in January or July). Activity Fees may be added to FACTS or paid in full upon acceptance. FACTS agreements must be submitted to the school by July 15th. Deductions take place on the 5th or 20th of the month depending on the date you select. For more information, please consult the included FACTS brochure. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the School Office.
2. If a **payment cannot be made**, please contact the school principal no less than six days before the deduction to avoid a NSF Check Fee. A \$25 NSF Check Fee will be charged for any deductions failed due to lack of funds.
3. **Tuition for Seniors** must be paid by May 20 for the student to graduate, and the school will not release **student school records** for owed tuition and fees.

Other Fees:

1. A **\$25 Late Registration Fee** will be charged to returning families who fail to Early Register their students by the given deadline.
2. Each student entering the school after the first day of school will be charged a **\$75 Book Fee** for special ordering and shipping of student textbooks.
3. The **AP Class Testing Fee** will be an additional fee for students taking AP class tests (i.e., College Board's Advanced Placement Program).

Refunds:

Tuition refunds will be calculated on the following basis:

1. The total tuition cost will be divided by the number of days of the school year (i.e., 180 days), which will equal the **daily tuition cost**. The number of days the student has been enrolled at FBCS will be multiplied by the daily tuition cost, which will equal the tuition owed to the school.
2. There is no refund for a parent's **third child** or more children.
