## WORSHIP ON SUNDAYS

**Doors 1 & 2** are the most convenient for traditional and contemporary worship.

We are a church whose unity is in Jesus, who gathers us around word and water, wine and bread. Our worship is the foundation of our faith. Worship is about what *God is doing* and *our response to God's loving action in our lives*. Worship is an encounter with God, who saves us through the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Our worship services have four basic movements:

**Gathering:** We sing, pray, and share God's peace.

**Hearing:** We hear the Word of God proclaimed through the reading of the Bible and preaching. We respond in faith through confessing our sins, receiving the promise of forgiveness, and songs, prayers, and offering.

**Celebrating:** We celebrate Holy Communion at every worship service. It is the Lord's Table, so everyone present is welcome to participate.

**Sending:** Filled and refreshed by our encounter with God, we are sent out into the world for mission through singing and words of blessing.

Every Wednesday we gather around the table. We start each evening at 5:30 with a meal served by one of our volunteer meal teams. # St. John Church Council

JULY 20, 2026

**Present:** Diane Menchhofer, Chad Sapp, Matt Gilmore, Myron Buxton, Ed Fuelling, Moriah Plattner, Lorna Saddler, Jen Roidt, Ron Heindel, Vicar Mary Miller, Ingrid Tebbe

**Opening:** Diane Menchhofer called the meeting to order and presented the devotional.

**Support Pastor Report:** Vicar Mary Miller's report highlighted completing her three-month evaluation for her internship and expressing enjoyment in leading worship and working alongside Pastor Dale Schaefer.

**Business Manager Report:** Summary of June Financial Report was presented. Council discussed questions of trajectory of giving in comparison to anticipated budget. Chad Sapp made a motion to accept June Financial Report; Matt Gilmore seconded. Motion passed.

**Staff Report:** Larissa Jackson, youth intern, is showing growth within her second month of the Education and Faith Formation Internship. Council recommended Larissa to formally introduce herself to the congregation during the blended service of Labor Day weekend. It was suggested Larissa could learn SubSplash to update the church's website. Updating the computer Larissa has been using to a newer model would broaden functionality.

Ingrid Tebbe is working towards updating church staff photos since there have been several changes to staffing since the last time photos were taken.

Junior high and high school youth are assisting Jenelle Gross with decorating the church this week for Vacation Bible School. VBS will occur from 6pm-8:30pm on July 27-30, and a celebration for participants and volunteers will be on July 31st at the Bryson Pool. Jenelle wished to extend appreciation to Kim Plattner for his work on preparing outdoor play areas in time for VBS.

**Committee Reports:** Vicar Mary presented highlights from the Worship Committee. Currently, no date has been set for the next meeting.

**Unfinished Business:** Diane Menchhofer made a motion to approve June Council Meeting Minutes; Ed Fuelling seconded. Motion passed.

**New Business:** Ron Heindel presented a report on the Car Show that occurred on July 12 with the Ice Cream Social. The Car Show had a record-breaking 192 entries and raised \$2300. Net proceeds from the Car Show will be donated to the Alzheimer's Foundation, St. John's Capital Improvement fund, and St. John's Youth fund. Improvements to consider for next year include having more volunteers to assist with registering entries, establishing an option to pre-register, and creating a QR code to facilitate ease of entry registration.

Jen Roidt presented on behalf of Community Engagement a report for the Ice Cream Social. Organizing the Ice Cream Social was a joint effort between Cheryl Heindel and

Community Engagement. The location of the Ice Cream Social in the Family Life Center and the golf cart transportation from parking to the venue by Dan and Kathy Snider were very well received, along with additions of a balloon artist and a bounce house to expand on activities for the family. The Ice Cream Social raised at least \$1600. Some of these proceeds will go to Our Home for their back-to-school drive.

Jen Roidt and Lorna Saddler brought to Council’s attention some complaints/suggestions of the congregation, such as having a detailed line-item budget printed in the congregation packets during congregational meeting. Other subjects included sharing names of confirmands in both service bulletins, adding contact information for Vicar Mary Miller and Pastor Dale Schaefer to the blue insert of bulletin, and sharing Council meeting minutes and church newsletters (with more info about church happenings) in a more timely manner. Discussion was held about church website management, restructuring and updating. Future plans for the parsonage the church rents from the city to be available for a future pastor was discussed and determined to keep this plan in place.

**Executive Session:** Council entered into executive session for approximately one hour to discuss personnel.

After Council exited the executive session, Matt Gilmore made a motion to replace Colin Brogan with Sarah Plattner for Visual Content Creator. Myron Buxton seconded motion. Motion passed with five in favor and one abstention.

**Adjournment and Prayer:** Diane Menchhofer called the meeting to adjournment. The Council meeting concluded with the Lord’s Prayer.

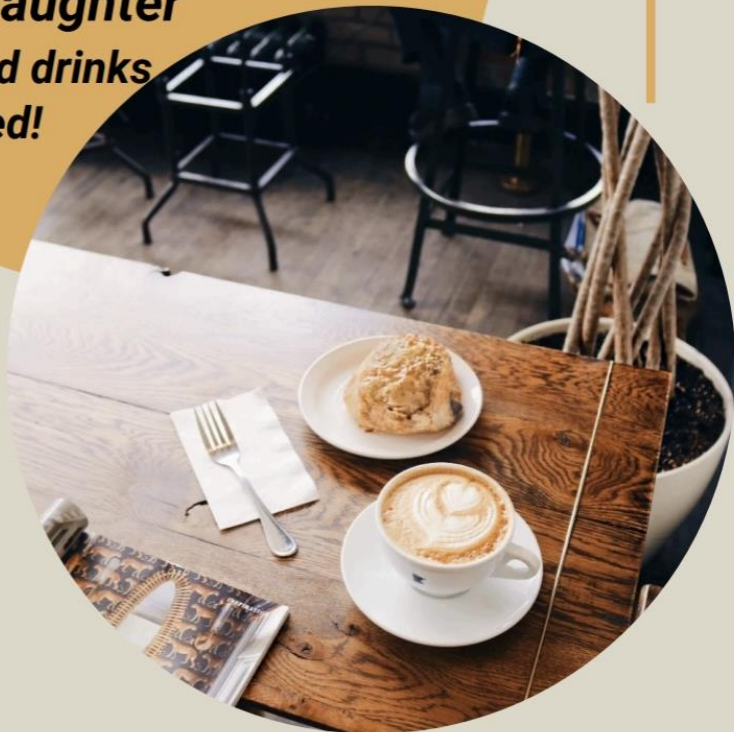

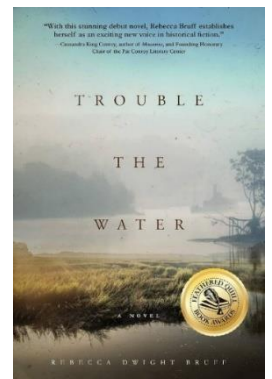
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## Book Club

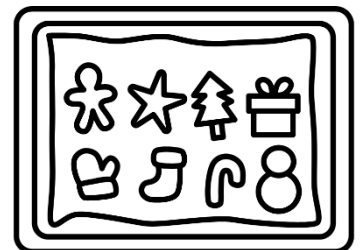
