Date	Scripture	Prayer
8/2	Galatians 4:1-3	<i>Lord, whether they be the Laws you have given or the shackles of this world, before Christ, we were enslaved to service, to seeking through human effort to please you, but in You, in Christ, we are forgiven and brought near because of what He has done. Praise be to God! Amen!</i>
3	Galatians 4:4-5	<i>Lord, we have been adopted as your beloved sons and daughters. That is the identity bestowed upon us through the blood of Christ. May we fully embrace this identity, given through your incredible love for us. In your name we pray, amen.</i>
4	Galatians 4:6	<i>Lord, how wonderful that we are invited to come to you as your Son came to you, crying out "Abba, Father!" To you in our times of need or celebration! Thank you, Lord for welcoming us into your family! Amen.</i>
5	Galatians 4:7	<i>Lord, we are no longer slaves, we are sons and daughters of the Most High God! May we come to you, unashamed through the efficacy of the cross and the power of the Holy Spirit. Amen.</i>
6	Galatians 4:1-7	<i>Lord, the good news of the Gospel is that though we could not rectify our sinfulness, you sent your Son to come and make atonement for our sins, welcoming us not only into freedom, but into your family. We are yours. Praise be your name. Amen.</i>

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7	Genesis 15:1-6	<i>Lord, what we experience being welcomed into your family is the fulfillment of the promise you made to Abraham all those years ago. You are ever faithful! Remind us of this truth when we face the difficulties of this world! Amen.</i>
8	Romans 8:14-17	<i>Lord, we are so easily distracted! Remind us of these words! May we not fall back into fear, but recognizing that we are adopted as sons and daughters. We need not return to the slavery we once lived in! In your name we pray, amen.</i>
9	Galatians 4:8-9	<i>Lord, before experiencing Christ, we were lost. We were enslaved to the ways of this world, even the religious practices we lived out day in and day out, seeking to please you. May we experience anew the cross and the reality that we are already free in you. You see us as holy and blameless through the blood of Christ. Amen.</i>
10	Galatians 4:10-11	<i>Lord, so easily we fall back into the traps we formerly were tricked by. We become religious instead of embracing the relationship we have with you. We seek to provide for ourselves instead of receiving what you've freely given. Forgive us, O God. Amen.</i>
11	Galatians 4:12	<i>Lord, may we remember who we are, who our brothers and sisters are, who YOU are. Be on the forefront of our minds, Lord. Our desire is for you. Amen.</i>
12	Galatians 4:13-14	<i>Lord, we need one another. We are uplifted by one another. Thank you for the blessing of biblical community. In your name we pray, amen.</i>
13	Galatians 4:15-16	<i>Lord, the world and the schemes of the enemy are so ridiculous, but we fall for them all the time, forgetting who we are in you! Forgive us, Lord! Remind us of our adoption, our sonship! In your name we pray, amen.</i>

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14	Galatians 4:17-18	<i>Lord, there are those wolves who pose as shepherds but who seek their own glorification instead of selflessly seeking to glorify only you. Help us to discern those who might lead us astray, and if we are those who seek glory for ourselves, humble us, Lord. Amen.</i>
15	Galatians 4:19-20	<i>Lord, may our love for one another be as family. We are family in You. Help us to be patient, and yet motivated with one another, spurring one another on, encouraging one another, admonishing one another in love. May we reflect you to one another in all we say and do. Amen.</i>
16	Galatians 4:21-23	<i>Lord, we are heirs through Abraham, through Christ! Remind us of our sonship, Lord! We are your beloved children, welcomed to the table through the sacrifice of your Son. Thank you, Jesus, Thank you. Amen.</i>
17	Galatians 4:24-25	<i>Lord, for years we were enslaved, to the ways of this world, to religious busyness... forgive us, Lord. We forget what is so foundational- who we are in You. Thank you for your patience with us, Lord. Amen.</i>
18	Galatians 4:26-27	<i>Lord, in you we are free! May we embrace our freedom in you! Amen.</i>
19	Galatians 4:28	<i>Lord, long before we were ever born, you said that we would become your people, not just your people but your children. Through Christ, in Christ, we are yours, welcomed to your table. Thank you, Jesus. Amen.</i>
20	Galatians 4:29-30	<i>Lord, the way that is right is hidden from us. We think we know the way, but our arrogance leads us astray. We think our ways are better than yours. Forgive us, God. Humble us. May we follow where you lead. Amen.</i>
21	Galatians 4:31	<i>Lord, we are not children of the slave, but of the free. Help us to live as those freed in Christ. Amen.</i>

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22	Romans 9:6-9	<i>Lord, though we may not be children of the flesh, we are children of the promise! Praise the Lord! We are counted, fully, as your children! We need not strive to achieve or possess your love. You have given it freely! Thank you, Jesus! Amen.</i>
23	Galatians 5:1	<i>Lord, for FREEDOM you have set us free. May we never submit again to the yoke of slavery! Amen.</i>
24	Galatians 5:2-4	<i>Lord, to return to seeking to earn salvation of our own accord is to reject Christ. Forgive us, Lord. May we receive your free gift, the freedom you bestow upon us as your children. May we not create stumbling blocks for those seeking to come to you and receive. Amen.</i>
25	Galatians 5:5-6	<i>Lord, we do not need to be perfect or live perfectly, but only believe, put our faith, our trust in You and you alone. Remind us of this truth, Lord. Amen.</i>
26	Galatians 5:7-8	<i>Lord, we need to be discerning of the voices we listen to. We need to know your voice so that we are not distracted or hindered from following where you might guide us. Give us ears to hear, Lord. Amen.</i>
27	Galatians 5:9	<i>Lord, may we not even mess with anything that smacks of selfrighteousness. Dipping a toe into those waters leads to us drowning and pulling others in with us. Keep it far from us, Lord. Amen.</i>
28	Galatians 5:10	<i>Lord, vengeance is not ours to take. Those that lead us astray will face your wrath. We need not take matters into our own hands. Let us have confidence that you are good and your ways lead to the glorification of your name. May we seek after you, always. Amen.</i>
29	Galatians 5:11-12	<i>Lord, Paul's words here are so hyperbolic and graphic, but such is the way when we move from doing what You desire to doing what makes sense to us. It leads us down paths that lead to our ruin. Forgive us, Lord! Amen.</i>

Date	Scripture	Prayer
30	John 8:31-36	<i>Lord, the truth will certainly set us free. We are free already in You. May we never pick up the shackles of slavery again. May we embrace our freedom in you. Amen.</i>
31	Romans 6:15-18	<i>Lord, when we keep our eyes and our hearts and our ears focused on you, listening to your Spirit, we will find ourselves walking in step with the Law, but not according to our own plans, but according to His. Thank you for the gift of your Spirit who guides us into becoming more like you. Amen.</i>
9/1	Romans 8:1-4	<i>Lord, we are no longer condemned according to the Law because we have been set free in You. You have done what the flesh could never do and we are eternally grateful for this precious gift. Thank you, Lord. Amen.</i>
2	Ephesians 2:8-10	<i>Lord, it is by GRACE we have been saved through faith. It is NOT of our own doing. We did not earn that which You have given! Thank you, Jesus! Amen.</i>
3	Colossians 2:6-15	<i>Lord, as we have received you, may we walk in step with you, being rooted in you in every area of our lives. In you, we have been made your people, having been buried with Him and raised with Him. Thank you, Lord. Amen.</i>
4	Hebrews 10:19-23	<i>Lord, may we have confidence in the truth of the Gospel in which we believe. May we entrust our entire lives, our entire bodies to the reality that you have opened the way for us into eternal life with you. Amen.</i>
5	1 Corinthians 9:19-23	<i>Lord, in our freedom, may we be selfless instead of selfish. May we give of ourselves for the sake of others because you gave yourself for us. Amen.</i>
6	2 Corinthians 3:17	<i>Lord, your Spirit lives within us and where your Spirit lives, there is freedom. In you, we are free. Amen.</i>
7	James 1:22-25	<i>Lord, may our faith drive us to works, not to earn our salvation, that is silly, but in response to it! Amen.</i>

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8	1 Peter 2:16	<i>Lord, may we live free, but not using our freedom to cover for our sinfulness. May we live free in you, both experiencing and sharing your love with all. Amen.</i>
9	Philippians 3:7-11	<i>Lord, in comparison to you, everything we once had is worthless. May we rejoice in the life we get to live in you, with its sufferings and all else. May we know you and the power of your resurrection, living with you for all eternity. Amen.</i>
10	Galatians 2:20	<i>Lord, we have been crucified with you and the lives we now live we do not live of our own accord, we live for you.</i>
11	Galatians 5:13-14	<i>Lord, we have been called to freedom. May we not use our freedom for evil. May we not use it to satisfy our flesh, but may we use it as the catalyst for living how You designed us to live, Lord. Amen.</i>
12	Galatians 5:1-12	<i>Lord, thank you for the freedom you have given us. We receive it this day and seek to live into it in every way. Forgive us for the ways in which we forget who you are, who we are and the path you have for us in light of your loving sacrifice. May we glorify you in all we say and do. Amen.</i>
