12	<p><i>"Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ,"</i> -Galatians 1:3</p>	<p>Lord, you have extended grace to us, may we extend it to one another. Bless us this day as we seek to be a blessing to those around us, reflecting your love to all we encounter. Amen.</p>
13	<p><i>"I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting him who called you in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel--"</i> -Galatians 1:6</p>	<p>Lord, so often our hearts are tempted by the things of this world, help us to remember you, to remember the Gospel and keep it central in our hearts and minds, viewing all the world through gospel-tinted lenses. Help us, Lord. Amen.</p>
14	<p><i>"But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach to you a gospel contrary to the one we preached to you, let him be accursed."</i> -Galatians 1:8</p>	<p>Lord, we need wisdom from you. So often the gospel is distorted and used for selfish gain. What sounds biblical is taken out of context and weaponized. Give us discernment when to listen, when to question, when to reject. May we rely on you and your Word alone. Amen.</p>
15	<p><i>"For am I now seeking the approval of man, or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ."</i> -Galatians 1:10</p>	<p>Lord, we all struggle with seeking after the approval of man. We desire for others to look up to us, to not consider us foolish, but to follow where you would guide means that we must give up our worldly identities and embrace our adoption as your sons and daughters. May we not seek to please man, but to be a servant of Christ. Amen.</p>
16	<p><i>"But when he who had set me apart before I was born, and who called me by his grace, was pleased to reveal his Son to me, in order that I might preach him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately consult with anyone;"</i> -Galatians 1:15-16</p>	<p>Lord, each of us have been set apart by you, set into our particular mission fields with particular gifts, particular longings, particular passions. May we recognize the unique role we play in the mission of the Kingdom and may we submit our lives to pursuit of your will, your way. Amen.</p>
17	<p><i>"Yet because of false brothers secretly brought in--who slipped in to spy out our freedom that we have in Christ Jesus, so that they might bring us into slavery-- to them we did not yield in submission even for a moment, so that the truth of the gospel might be preserved for you."</i> -Galatians 2:4-5</p>	<p>Lord, so often we are guilty of forgetting that we are free in you and we submit ourselves to the yoke of slavery. In you, we are free. Remind us of this reality and may we live in light of it today and every day. In your name we pray, amen.</p>

18	<p><i>"yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified."</i> -Galatians 2:16</p>	<p>Lord, we are aware that we are not saved by works. We understand that we are saved by faith in you and what you've done, though, James says, that faith is lived out via works. May we be a people who receive their justification freely from you and may that salvation come through us in service to others for the sake of your Kingdom. Amen.</p>
19	<p><i>"For through the law I died to the law, so that I might live to God. I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me."</i> -Galatians 2:19-20</p>	<p>Lord, we are not our own. Our lives are not our own. Our former selves have died with Christ and the life we live now is lived for you. Remind us of this reality as we go about our daily tasks. May we remember that the lives we live, we live by faith in you. Amen.</p>
20	<p><i>"I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness were through the law, then Christ died for no purpose."</i> -Galatians 2:21</p>	<p>Lord, may we not reject the salvation you bring by seeking to try to earn our righteousness on our own. You have given it to us freely, though it cost you much. May we never forget what you've done for us and seek to do it on our own. Thank you, Jesus. Amen.</p>
21	<p><i>"O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? It was before your eyes that Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified."</i> -Galatians 3:1</p>	<p>Lord, we know that you died, that you rose and this reality has validated the truth of your words. May we have confidence in this reality and seek to hold onto this truth with all that we are, not forsaking that which we first believed. Amen.</p>
22	<p><i>"Let me ask you only this: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith? Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh?"</i> -Galatians 3:2-3</p>	<p>Lord, we have not received anything on our own. We have received your Spirit only through your work on the cross. It is not by works which we have been saved. Praise your name. Amen.</p>
23	<p><i>"Does he who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you do so by works of the law, or by hearing with faith—"</i> -Galatians 3:5</p>	<p>Lord, so often we get bogged down in returning to our former way of life. We think that we need to do more in order to be saved. Remind us that it is not about what we've done but about what you've done and then allow us to live lives of thankfulness to you. Amen.</p>
24	<p><i>"just as Abraham "believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness?"</i> -Galatians 3:6</p>	<p>Lord, our forefathers have given us both models to follow and cautions to be aware of. May we aspire to have faith like Abraham, yet not doubt as the years creep by waiting for your promises to be fulfilled. You are faithful, ever faithful. Amen.</p>
25	<p><i>" Now before faith came, we were held captive under the law, imprisoned until the coming faith would be revealed. So then, the law was our guardian until Christ came, in order that we might be justified by faith."</i> -Galatians 3:23-24</p>	<p>Lord, your Law is good, but it is not the path to life. In YOU do we find life. Remind us of this reality whenever we get mired in our former pursuits. You give us life in you. In your name we pray, amen.</p>

26	<p><i>"for in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith."</i> -Galatians 3:26</p>	<p>Lord, we are your beloved, adopted sons and daughters! May we never forget this reality, but embrace it fully every day! Amen!</p>
27	<p><i>"For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus."</i> -Galatians 3:27-28</p>	<p>Lord, in you we may be diverse, but we are one. In you, we are all adopted as your children and that identity is our primary identity. We are one in Christ Jesus! Praise be to God! Amen.</p>
28	<p><i>"And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise."</i> -Galatians 3:29</p>	<p>Lord, we have been grafted into the family, we are your people. You are our God and we praise you for your deep affection and willingness to go to the cross that we might be adopted by you through your blood. Amen.</p>
29	<p><i>"But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons."</i> -Galatians 4:4-5</p>	<p>Lord, you came and placed yourself under the law to live out the law perfectly and then to die on our behalf that we might live. Thank you, Jesus. Amen.</p>
30	<p><i>"And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, 'Abba! Father!' So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God."</i> -Galatians 4:6-7</p>	<p>Lord, we can cry out to you as sons and daughters, fearless because we are able to run to you, to jump into your arms, trusting that our sin does not separate us from you! Thank you, Jesus! Amen.</p>
1	<p><i>"my little children, for whom I am again in the anguish of childbirth until Christ is formed in you!"</i> -Galatians 4:19</p>	<p>Lord, your love for us is immeasurable. The lengths to which you have gone for us brings us to awe. May we regularly choose to pause and to contemplate your incredible love for us and may it draw us to you in worship. Amen.</p>
2	<p><i>"Tell me, you who desire to be under the law, do you not listen to the law?"</i> -Galatians 4:21</p>	<p>Lord, our hearts can be so hard. We desire a clear path, clear direction, but when given it, we fail, so we turn our eyes outward and look at others and judge their misgivings and sin, forgetting our own. Help us, Lord. May we embrace our freedom in you and extend it, through mercy and grace, to others. Amen.</p>
3	<p><i>"Now you, brothers, like Isaac, are children of promise."</i> -Galatians 4:28</p>	<p>Lord, when we read the Hebrew Scriptures, may we make it a point to place ourselves into the story. We are Joseph. We are Isaac. We are Ezekiel. May we remember that we are now part of your family and the Hebrew story of restoration is now our story as well. In your name we pray, amen.</p>
4	<p><i>"For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery."</i> -Galatians 5:1</p>	<p>Lord, we have been freed for freedom's sake to extend freedom to the world. May we not return to the yoke of slavery, placing the shackles back on our wrists and ankles. We are free in you. Praise be your name! Amen.</p>

5	<p><i>"For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only faith working through love."</i> -Galatians 5:6</p>	<p>Lord, the things we do, our physical bodies, the boxes we check do not count for anything. We are yours through faith alone. Remind us of this truth, Lord. Amen.</p>
6	<p><i>"For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another."</i> -Galatians 5:13</p>	<p>Lord, in our freedom we are not to go forth and cause more damage. We are free to extend freedom to others. Help us, Lord Jesus. Amen.</p>
7	<p><i>"For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."</i> -Galatians 5:14</p>	<p>Lord, may we be beacons for your love to every person we meet, reflections of you. May we see people how you see them. Amen.</p>
8	<p><i>"But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh."</i> -Galatians 5:16</p>	<p>Lord, if we walk as you desire us to walk, we will not fall into sin. We know we are forgiven if we do, but may we see that as an invitation to continue to grow in our ability to hear and follow where you would guide us. Amen.</p>
9	<p><i>"For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do."</i> -Galatians 5:17</p>	<p>Lord, make our desires your desires. Incline our hearts to you so that the things we chase after are the things you would have us chase after. Redeem what is flesh in us that we might walk in step with your Spirit. Amen.</p>
10	<p><i>"Now the works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God."</i> -Galatians 5:19-20</p>	<p>Lord, may we take a moment today and look at the fruit our life is bearing, be it good fruit or rotten fruit. May we not be filled with shame or guilt if our fruit is not good; instead, may we see this as a blessing that we can take stock and take this opportunity to repent and return to you that we might be transformed by your Spirit. Thank you, Lord. Amen.</p>
11	<p><i>"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law."</i> -Galatians 5:22-23</p>	<p>Lord, we all learned this verse in Sunday School, but how often have we taken a hard look at our lives and seen whether we see these fruits being born in them? Help us to look and see how your Spirit is working in us, how He is bearing fruit in our lives. Amen.</p>
12	<p><i>"And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit."</i> -Galatians 5:24-25</p>	<p>Lord, we are yours. Help us to realize that our lives are not our own and that we belong to you. Let us live as such. Amen.</p>
13	<p><i>"Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another."</i> -Galatians 5:26</p>	<p>Humble us, Lord. May we be quick to hear your correction and not get caught up in arrogantly treating one another as if we matter more than they do. May we have soft hearts and may we be quick to repent. Amen.</p>

14	<p><i>"Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted. Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ."</i> -Galatians 6:1-2</p>	<p>Lord, when we confront a brother or sister on their sinfulness, may we do it with grace and mercy, knowing that Christ's mercy extends all the way to them because we recognize that it extends all the way to our sinfulness as well. Let us bear one another's burdens, doing life in community. Amen.</p>
15	<p><i>"And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up."</i> -Galatians 6:9</p>	<p>Lord, give us the energy and stamina to continue to do good, though the way be rough. May we lean on you and trust that your way is always best. In your name we pray, amen.</p>
