We pray that they would be encouraged to speak what you have spoken to them and that your people might hear your words. Bless them, give them confidence in you, endurance in the journey, and a growing passion for you in their lives. In your Son's name, Amen." (A prayer for our Pastors)	Who is a Pastor, a Christian Leader, an Elder, a Mentor who has encouraged you in your walk with Jesus?
2	1 Tim. 3:1-2	Elders	"Lord Jesus, the task of leading your church is a high calling. Elders are held to a higher standard, under greater scrutiny, subject to harsher judgment. These men and women you've appointed over our church need our prayers daily. Lord, we lift up our elders to you. Help us to respect and honor them as they direct the affairs of our church. Bless their families, their ministries, their lives. May they lead well as you direct their thoughts and actions. Amen." Help them in their walk with you that they might keep their focus on you to be nourished, fulfilled, encouraged as they seek to extend your love, your provision for those in need. Give them wisdom as they council those who are struggling in our church and in our community. Thank you, Father, for their faithful obedience. In your Son's name, Amen." (A prayer for our Deacons)	Who is someone who has come to be the hands of Christ in a time of need?
4	Eph. 4:1	Congregation	Lord, your Apostle Paul had such a love for the local church! He often prayed for it and sought to challenge and encourage it to faithfulness and resolve in the face of whatever persecution they might face. With this example, we seek to pray for our own congregation of Jesus followers at our church. Encourage us to stay the course, to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which we have been called. Encourage us, bless us, help us to be reminded of you and your faithfulness as we seek to minister to a hurting world. Amen." For those navigating these difficult times, the pathway is often unclear, and the repercussions for wrong decisions and actions can be life-altering. With this in mind, we pray for our youth. Help them to pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, seeking to honor you in their lives. May our church family surround them and lift them up in prayer, encouragement, and support, however, they may need it during this challenging time of life. We pray this in your name, Amen." We thank you for the years of faithful service and the dedication they give still as they strive to continue ministry right up until you call them home. Their legacy in you is being carried forward through the children, youth, and young families at our church. As time takes its toll and our earthly bodies begin to bear the signs of a life lived for Jesus, I pray that we would be encouraged, supported, and loved well by our church family. Thank you for those older generations at our church who have been and continue to be a vital part of our church body. We pray for them in your name, Amen."  (A prayer for our Seniors)	There are many faithful seniors in our church family-seek to meet a new one this week!
8	1 Thes. 1:5	The Lost	"Lord Jesus, we pray for those who don't know you in our communities, in our families, even in our congregation. We pray that we might live lives that proclaim the Gospel in word and deed. Help your Spirit move in us to share how you have worked in our lives and how you transform us into being people in your likeness. 9	2 Chron. 20:21-22	Worship Leaders	"Lord, in the spiritual battle we find ourselves in, those who lead us in worship are our company commanders, guiding us into battle against the sin within us and the injustice we face daily in our world. Thank you for those who center our minds and hearts on you. Help encourage them as they lead us into lives of worship, not just during our weekly service, but in every moment of every day. Help them to model well a life lived for you that we might follow them into battle. Amen." (A prayer for our Worship Leaders)	Thank one of the worship leaders for their service and consider telling them how they lead you in worship.
10	Proverbs 31:30	Women's Ministry	"Lord, our church is blessed by women who dedicate their whole lives to you. Thank you that we do not have to look far to find women who model well what it means to be a Proverbs 31 woman. There are women, young and old, who are leading significant ministries in our church, and we thank you for their dedication, their gifting, and their passion for you. Help enable them to be bold leaders in your Kingdom who seek to submit themselves to you and give themselves for others in love. In your name, Amen." 12	1 Tim. 4:12	Youth Workers	"Lord, our church is blessed with so many youth workers who work in youth ministry. They are dedicated people passionate about teens growing in their relationship with Jesus. Lord, we pray for their efforts, for their stamina, for wisdom, and for their personal walks with you. We lift them up to you and ask you to bless them and grant them the ability to do that you've called them. In your Son's name, Amen." (A prayer for Youth Workers)	Seek out a Youth leader and pray for them as they minister to the youth of our church family.
13	1 Cor. 16:15	Behind-the- Scenes workers	"Holy Spirit, there are so many people in our church that work behind the scenes doing ministries that often no one even knows about. Thank you for those called to do the ministries that bless so many, but that often gets overlooked. Bless our brothers and sisters who serve in this capacity and help them to know in their hearts that their service is as valuable to the body of Christ as any other service. Thank you that we all are given different gifts and that all of these gifts are for the entire body to flourish and bring glory to you. Amen."	Keep your eyes peeled for those who are behind the scenes helping in all the different ways needed at our church and make sure they know that you appreciate them and see them and the work they do for our church family.
14	Mk 10:14	Children's Ministry workers	"Jesus, you say that the Kingdom of God belongs to the little children. You tell your disciples to allow them to come to you. From those holding babies in the nursery to those praying with the 3-5 year olds, we thank you for them all. 15	Mk 11:17	Prayer Ministry	"Lord, in prayer, we get to be in communion with you individually and corporately as we gather to pray. Today, we pray for our various prayer ministries at our church; the prayer chain, prayer night, prayer ministry on Sunday mornings, Outreach prayer team, and all the other various prayer ministries at our church. Charles Spurgeon used to say that the prayer ministry that occurred every Sunday in the church's basement was the engine room of the whole church. This is still the case. Our church's prayer ministry and the individual prayers of our church family drive our church, and it's impact for the Kingdom. Thank you, Father, for this blessed ministry, and bless those who participate in it. Amen."  (A prayer for our Prayer Ministry)	Visit Prayer Night or come up after service on Sunday and pray with the Prayer team this week.
16	Rev. 3:14-18	Spiritual-Level	"Lord, we pray today for the spiritual growth of our congregation. It is very easy to slip into complacency and to be stagnant in our faith. Challenge us, O Lord, that we may press in on you. Devote our hearts to your Word and your minds to meditating on your teaching. Fill us with your Holy Spirit and transform us into your likeness. Through love, you give us the unity of Spirit and action in the church. May we be people known for their lovingkindness both with one another and with the surrounding world. Amen."  (A prayer for Love and Unity)	Who is someone you need to reach out to in love and share how much you appreciate them?

20	2 Cor. 9:6-11	Finances	"Lord, you've blessed us with everything we have. We confess that at times we can think that you operate out of scarcity instead of abundance, assuming that you will somehow run out of blessings, so we hold tightly to that which you've given. You bless us that we might be a blessing. May we be cheerful givers, giving glory to the giver of all things. Thank you, Father, for your incredible blessings. Amen." (A prayer for our Finances)	Take a moment and offer up all of your finances to the Lord for Him to use as He sees fit and be obedient to how He calls you to use these blessings He gives.
21	Heb. 13:16	Outreach/ Missions Projects	"Lord Jesus, the work we do for your Kingdom, we are blessed to be able to do in our local community and all over the world. You have been generous with us, and we have been able to be generous in the resources we've been able to use in global and local outreach. Guide us as we do this work, O Lord. May we do that which you have called us to and prayerfully continue to support your ministries here and abroad. Amen." (A prayer for Outreach Ministries)	Go by the Outreach Wall and pray for one of our partners overseas.
22	2 Cor. 12:9	Single Parents	"Jesus, you are perfect and yet came into an imperfect world. The world we navigate is rife with issues, difficulties, situations that are not ideal, and yet, this is where you work. This morning we recognize that there are many single parents in our community who are raising children independently. It is arduous work, and yet it is good work. You have not abandoned the single mother or father; you are present with them. Encourage them, draw them near to you that they may draw their children near to you. May our church family embrace and support these families in the effort of raising godly children who will grow to glorify you. Amen." (A prayer for Single Parents)	Find a single parent in our church and let them know that they are doing a great job raising their children. Offer to help if you are able.
23	Gen. 16:13	Those Hurting	"Father, you are present with us even when we find it hard to see you. Remind those of us who are hurting in this season that you are here, you have blessed us with the body of Christ, and that you are working in the midst of whatever trial we are going through. Draw near to those who are hurting and comfort the hearts of those dealing with loss. We lift these people up to you. In your Son's name, Amen." (A prayer for those Hurting)	Ask God who in our church family could use some extra love and support and be obedient to go where He calls you.
24	Rom. 8:1	Freedom from Sin	"Jesus, our Savior, we praise your name! Through your sacrifice, we are freed from sin! May we not take your sacrifice lightly, and may we be quick to confess and repent of our sins. In you, we are free and can overcome any sin through your Holy Spirit. Let us not get mired in the struggle, but celebrate in our newfound identity in Christ! Glory be to God! Amen!" It builds idols out of business, wealth, leisure, comfort, or even the American dream. All that matters in the life of those born again is the Kingdom of Heaven and living in light of its truth. Keep our focus on you. May we repent, for the Kingdom of God is at hand. In your Son's name and through His sacrifice, Amen."  (A prayer for Kingdom-focus)	Consider your calendar/schedule this next year. How can you orchestrate your life to be more Kingdom-minded this next year?
26	Acts 2:47	Evangelistic Efforts	"Lord, you are the one who grows ministries and churches.
