Sermon Series Summary | Freedom

As we return to our study of Galatians, we pick up with one of Paul's most passionate questions: Why return to slavery when Christ has set you free? In Galatians 4, Paul reminds us that through Jesus we are no longer slaves, but sons and daughters of God. We've been brought from idols to the living God, from strangers to family, and from bondage to freedom.

Sermon Summary | From Slavery to Freedom

We cannot earn what only God can give, be it through religious performance, human efforts, or any other way. It is imperative that we recognize our identity as God's beloved children if we desire to experience true freedom in Christ.

Discussion Questions

- 1.What stands out to you in the text?
- 2.Paul contrasts two ways of relating to God: through human effort or through God's promise. Where are people tempted to rely on their own effort instead of trusting what God has done?
- 3.Why do you think it can be tempting to return to "slavery" (earning approval, proving ourselves, or relying on rules) even after experiencing the freedom of Christ?
- 4.Paul reminds the Galatians that they are children of promise. How does knowing that we are chosen, loved, and adopted by God change the way we see ourselves?
- 5.What is one area of your life where you need to live more like a free child of God rather than someone trying to earn their place?

Notes:

Respond Throughout the Week

- **Pray** - Throughout your week, dedicate time to listening to and speaking with the Lord.
- **Read** - Feed your soul with God's Word daily. Review the Scriptures used in the sermon.
- **Journal** - Write a summary of what you're hearing from God each day. Write out your prayers.
- **Worship** - Take time to thank God for who He is, be grateful, and respond in praise.
- **Intercede** - Pray for someone who needs prayer, and consider inviting someone to pray for you.
- **Give** - Ask God how to bless others with what He's given you. Give generously and joyfully.
- **Serve** - Choose to join the Lord in what He's doing in our church and in our community.
