Sermon Series Summary | Life in the Spirit

What does it look like to live a life shaped by the presence of God? Join us as we discover a way of following Jesus that isn't built on striving, proving ourselves, or simply trying harder. It begins with receiving the love and grace of God and learning to walk in step with His Spirit. As the Spirit transforms us from the inside out, His love begins to take shape in our lives, in how we love and serve one another, and how we join God in His work in the world.

Sermon Summary | The Law of Love

What does it actually mean to be free in Christ? Paul reminds us that Christian freedom isn't freedom to simply pursue whatever we want –it's freedom to become who we were created to be. Rooted in the truth that we are already deeply loved by God, we no longer have to strive, prove ourselves, or earn our worth. Instead, we are free to turn toward others and serve one another humbly in love.

Jesus invites us to become working lovers rather than loving workers—people whose lives and service flow from receiving God's love rather than trying to earn it. As we learn to live from our identity as God's beloved, His love begins to overflow into the way we see, serve, and love the people around us.

Discussion Questions

- 1.What stands out to you in the text?
- 2.When you hear Paul say that you have been “called to be free,” what does freedom in Christ mean to you? How is that different from the way our culture usually talks about freedom?
- 3.Paul connects receiving freedom with serving others in love. Why do you think experiencing God's love for us changes the way we love other people? Where have you experienced that in your own life?
- 4.Who is God inviting you to love and serve right now? What would it look like this week to serve that person, not out of obligation, but from the freedom of knowing and experiencing that you are deeply loved by God?

Notes:

Respond Throughout the Week

- **Pray** - Throughout your week, dedicate time to listening to and speaking with the Lord.
- **Read** - Feed your soul with God's Word daily. Review the Scriptures used in the sermon.
- **Journal** - Write a summary of what you're hearing from God each day. Write out your prayers.
- **Worship** - Take time to thank God for who He is, be grateful, and respond in praise.
- **Intercede** - Pray for someone who needs prayer, and consider inviting someone to pray for you.
- **Give** - Ask God how to bless others with what He's given you. Give generously and joyfully.
- **Serve** - Choose to join the Lord in what He's doing in our church and in our community.
