As we return to our study of Galatians, we pick up with one of Paul's most passionate questions: Why return to slavery when Christ has set you free? In Galatians 4, Paul reminds us that through Jesus we are no longer slaves, but sons and daughters of God. We've been brought from idols to the living God, from strangers to family, and from bondage to freedom.

We have been set free in Christ, yet we often return to that which is familiar. To return to living as we once did is to return to slavery, to make an idol out of spiritual practices, and to count on something other than Christ to save us. This is not the path to life and certainly not the path to freedom.

Galatians 5:1-12

Discussion Questions

- 1.What stands out to you in the text?
- 2.What does it mean to be truly free in Christ? How is the freedom Paul talks about different from our modern, American idea of freedom?
- 3.The Galatians were tempted to add religious practices to what Jesus had already done. What are some things people today might add to the Gospel that can make them feel like they have to earn God’s love?
- 4.What is the difference between obeying God because we are loved by Him and obeying God in order to earn His love? Why does that difference matter?
- 5.Paul says that “faith working through love” is what matters (v. 6). How does understanding our freedom in Christ change the way we love and serve othersVerse 1 says, “For freedom Christ has set us free.”?

Notes:

Respond Throughout the Week

- **Pray** - Throughout your week, dedicate time to listening to and speaking with the Lord.
- **Read** - Feed your soul with God’s Word daily. Review the Scriptures used in the sermon.
- **Journal** - Write a summary of what you’re hearing from God each day. Write out your prayers.
- **Worship** - Take time to thank God for who He is, be grateful, and respond in praise.
- **Intercede** - Pray for someone who needs prayer, and consider inviting someone to pray for you.
- **Give** - Ask God how to bless others with what He’s given you. Give generously and joyfully.
