ASK FOR THE DOUBLE ANOINTING

"And it came to pass, when they were gone over, that Elijah said unto Elisha, Ask what I shall do for thee, before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray thee, let a DOUBLE PORTION of thy spirit be upon me" (II Kings 2:9).

Recall the story of Elisha following Elijah across the Jordon River to the place where he would depart to heaven. Elisha knew that Elijah would be taken to heaven that very day. He was not the only one with this knowledge. Several of the sons of the prophets were also aware of this departure. However, Elisha was the only one that followed Elijah.

Just minutes before he was taken up into heaven by a Chariot of Fire, and Horses of Fire, Elijah told Elisha to ASK. Elijah knew that this was the way to receive. To Ask God in an attitude of Faith is the key to prayers being answered. Without hesitation, Elisha asked for a DOUBLE PORTION of his spirit. This was not a selfish request. Rather, this request reflected his desire for God's Spirit.

DOUBLE PORTION

The Scriptures portray the idea of a DOUBLE PORTION with the concept of a DOUBLE BLESSING! Often, it was referred to as the BIRTHRIGHT. "Instead, he shall acknowledge the son of the unloved as the firstborn, by giving him a double portion of all that he has, for he was the beginning of his strength (generative power), to him belongs the right of the firstborn" (Deuteronomy 21:17).

Another example of the DOUBLE PORTION included Hannah's husband. He gave her a double portion because of his love for her.

SEE ME

Elijah made it very clear that if Elisha saw him when he departed that he would receive the double portion. However, if he did not see him depart, Elisha would not receive this double portion! (II Kings 2:10) To SEE Elijah depart required an act of faith and obedience. This is a message for intercessors today. We must pray with EYES OF FAITH. "But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him" (Hebrews 11:6).

TWICE THE MIRACLES

The Scriptures confirm that Elisha performed twice as many miracles as Elijah. There were 28 miracles reported in the ministry of Elisha. In the ministry of Elijah, there are 14 recorded miracles.

THOSE WHO ASK

For those who desire more of God's Presence, they must be like Elisha! ASK what you desire! ASK with EYES OF FAITH! ASK and receive!

"Hitherto have you asked nothing in my name: ask, and you shall receive, that your joy may be full" (John 16:24).
