

OLD TESTAMENT

14. **2 Chronicles:** Judah's kings and temple worship illustrate faithfulness versus rebellion.
15. **Ezra:** God restores His people and the temple after exile.
16. **Nehemiah:** God's people rebuild Jerusalem and renew the covenant.
17. **Esther:** God protects His people through courage and providence.
18. **Job:** God's sovereignty and faithfulness are shown amid suffering.
19. **Psalms:** Expressions of praise, lament, and trust in God.
