Before you dive into this booklet of devotionals we want to give you a few things to remember as you read and work through:

First, try not to think of or write down the “right” answers! Part of this week is allowing God to work in and through us, imperfect vessels, who He loves very much! Sometimes it’s better to sit in silence without an answer, then to jump to one you’ve heard from somewhere else!



Second, allow your morning devotional time to be a pause! We’ll have PLENTY of work, fun, activity, and rushing around this week, but probably a lot less time to sit, reflect, and consider. So take this time to do just that. Don’t worry about how long you’ve been sitting, or about whether anyone else is done already, pause and allow this time to flow as quickly or slowly as it may, and hopefully God will be at work to shape and use it as He wills!

Finally, feel free to do this devotional at any time. We’ll have dedicated times in the morning, but feel free to get up earlier, to take a moment or two between activities, or to find some time in the evenings to revisit or expand on your devotional time.

Throughout this week we want our service to be meaningful, and in many ways, that involves our own growth, challenge, and change, so don’t hesitate to engage just as much in those areas as you do the work projects, worship, and fun that we plan to do this week!

AS YOU GO THROUGH EACH DEVOTIONAL, TAKE TIME TO LOOK FOR THE WAYS GOD’S CHARACTER IS SHOWN OR FOUND IN THE QUALITIES WE ARE STUDYING!

REMEMBER THAT OUR ABILITY TO DISPLAY THESE QUALITIES IS FOUND IN HOW CLOSELY WE FOLLOW GOD, AND THAT THE PURPOSE OF DISPLAYING THEM IS TO GLORIFY HIM!

MONDAY – WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO DO JUSTICE? WHY IS THAT IMPORTANT TO GOD?

MICAH 6:8, GALATIANS 3:10-29

Justice isn't only punishment for wrongdoing. True justice is when the world exists in accordance with God's character! When God tells us to "do justice" it means to act according to His desire and design! Honoring the things that should be honored, caring for the things that should be cared for, and ridding ourselves of things that go against God's character, namely any kind of evil or wickedness!

we are to Him, the more of Him people will see in us!

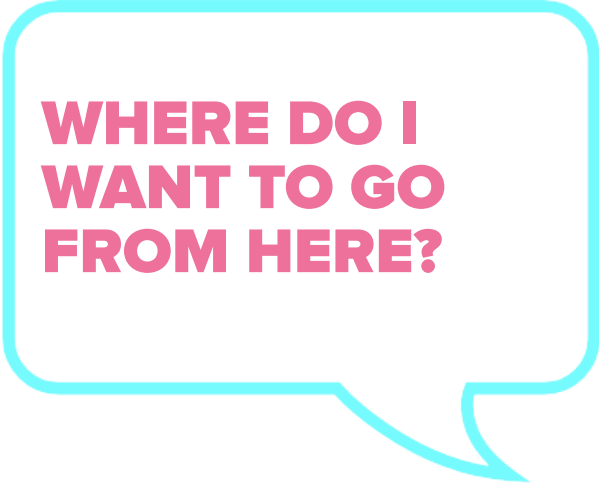
