1. What does the formerly blind man's response to Jesus in verses 35–38 teach us about what genuine faith in Christ looks like?
2. Why is recognizing our spiritual blindness necessary for seeing Jesus rightly? What can make it difficult for us to admit our need for Him?
3. In verse 39, Jesus says that He came so that “those who do not see may see, and those who see may become blind.” What does He mean, and how do the blind man and the Pharisees illustrate these two responses?
4. The Pharisees' confidence in their own spiritual sight actually kept them from seeing Jesus. What are some ways self-righteousness or self-reliance can show up in the life of a Christian?
5. The healed man responds, “Lord, I believe,” and worships Jesus. If Jesus has opened our eyes to see Him, what should a life of worship look like practically—in our marriages, work, parenting, relationships, and other areas of life?
