Opening

- Growing up, what did you think Communion or the Lord's Supper meant?
- How often did your church practice Communion, and what did it feel like to you at the time?

1. Rescue Story

- The sermon said the Lord's Supper is rooted in a rescue story. How does the Passover story help us understand what Jesus did for us? In what ways is The Lord's Supper similar and what ways is it different from Passover?
- Why is it significant that Jesus is the Lamb in the new rescue story?
- The sermon emphasized that salvation is rooted in grace, not our goodness. Why is this important to remember?
- How does remembering the story of Jesus' sacrifice help keep the gospel central in our lives?

2. Relationship Agreement

- Jesus said the cup represents the new covenant in His blood (Luke 22:20). What does this teach us about our relationship with God?
- How does Jesus' sacrifice make it possible for a holy God to remain in relationship with sinful people?
- How does Communion act as a sign that reminds us of God's love and faithfulness? How do physical signs help us remember spiritual truths and promises?
- How should remembering Christ's sacrifice during Communion affect the way we live during the week?
