A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church Family,

One of the repeated commands in the New Testament is to stand firm. Paul writes, "Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord" (1 Corinthians 15:58). In a world that constantly shifts in its values, beliefs, and priorities, Christians are called to stand firm in the truth of Christ. But here is something we often overlook: **You will never stand firm in your faith if you are not passing your faith on to someone else.**

Faith was never meant to stop with us. It was meant to move through us. Paul told Timothy, "What you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also" (2 Timothy 2:2). Notice the pattern – Paul to Timothy, Timothy to faithful men, faithful men to others. This is how the church stays strong from generation to generation.

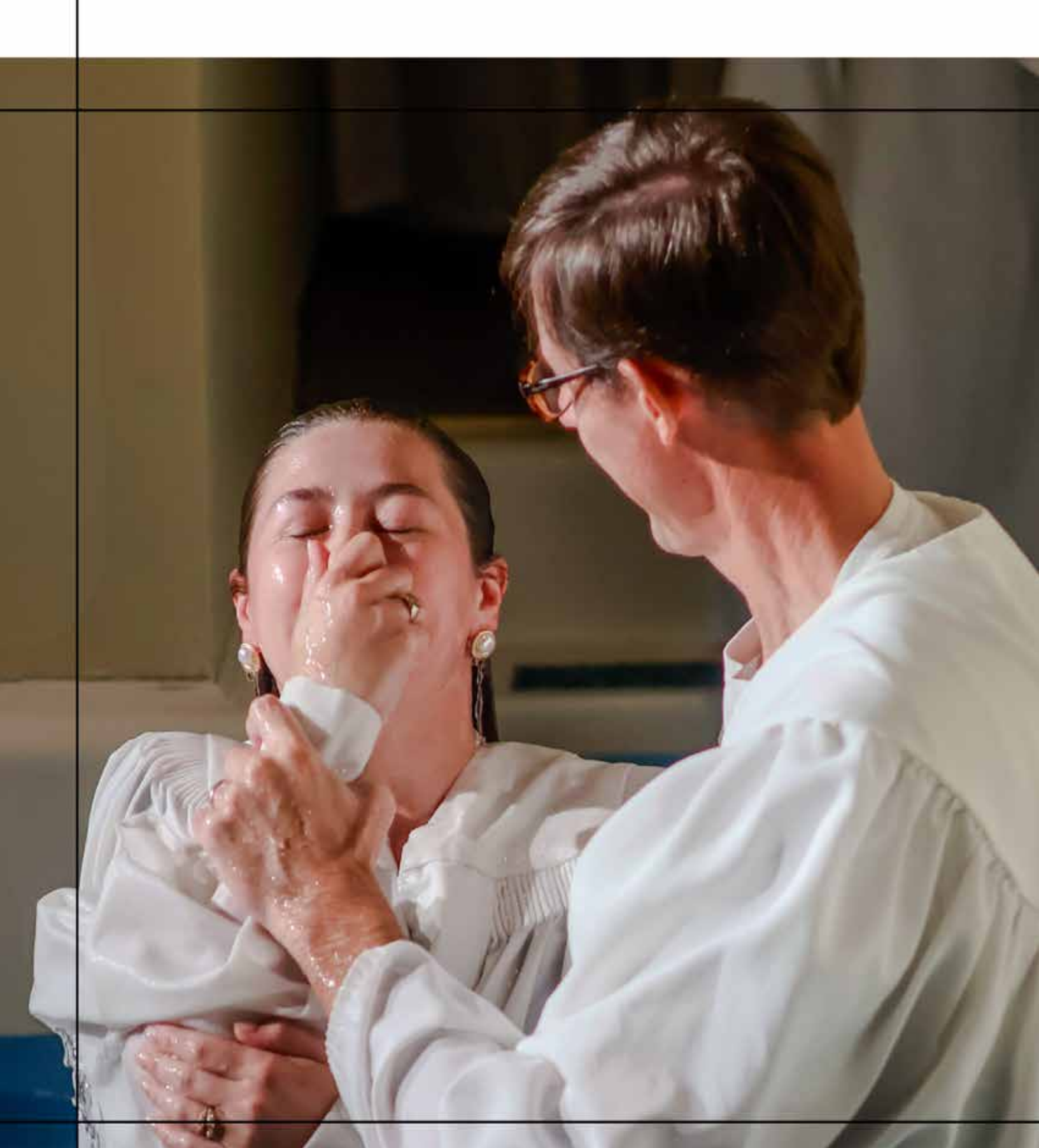
It has been said, "Inheritance is what you leave *for* someone. Legacy is what you leave *in* someone." Most hard-working people save up for retirement and have a desire to leave their children an inheritance. That's a good thing, but even greater is leaving a legacy of faith in the hearts of others – their children, church, and community.

If you want to stand firm, you need two relationships in your life: Someone you are learning from, and someone you are pouring into. You need people who strengthen your faith, challenge you, and help you grow. And you need people who are watching your life, learning from your example, and being encouraged by your walk with Christ.


Hebrews 10:23-24 says, "Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering... and let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works." We stand firm best when we stand together – learning, teaching, encouraging, and passing the faith on. Let's be a church that is not only holding the faith, but handing it down.

Growing in Mind & Spirit

A deep dive into the spiritual and physical development of our 4-year-olds & 4th graders

Four-year-olds experience rapid growth both physically and spiritually as they explore the world around them. At this age, children typically show improved coordination and strength. They can run, jump, climb, and balance more confidently than before. Fine motor skills also develop quickly; many four-year-olds enjoy drawing shapes, using scissors, building with small blocks, and dressing themselves. Their bodies are becoming stronger and more controlled, allowing them to participate in more active play and simple organized activities.

Spiritually, four-year-olds are beginning to form an early sense of wonder, empathy, and awareness of values. They often ask big questions about life, nature, and people. This curiosity can open the door to conversations about kindness, gratitude, and caring for others. Many children at this age enjoy simple prayers, songs, or stories that teach love, honesty, and helping others. They may not fully understand complex spiritual ideas, but they can grasp basic concepts like being thankful, sharing, and recognizing when something is right or wrong.

Overall, the fourth year of life is a time of exciting development. As children gain physical abilities and begin to explore deeper questions about the world, supportive guidance helps them grow into confident, caring individuals.

Fourth graders are at an exciting stage of growth physically, emotionally, and spiritually. At this age, children are growing quickly and beginning to notice the entire world and the people who live in it. They are becoming more aware that God loves and values people everywhere, not just those in their own families, schools, or communities.

Emotionally, fourth graders are developing a deeper ability to understand others and think about what people believe and feel. This growing awareness helps them see how God's love extends to people all around the world.

Spiritually, their understanding of God is also deepening. Many fourth graders are beginning to grasp important truths about who God is, that He is faithful and all-powerful. They are also learning that God showed His great love for us by sending Jesus.

At this age, children can understand the meaning of the gospel more clearly. They are learning that Jesus died to pay the penalty for sin and that salvation is the beginning of a growing relationship with Jesus that lasts forever. Through salvation, their sins are forgiven, and they begin a lifelong journey of knowing and following Him.

As fourth graders continue to grow, the church has a wonderful opportunity to encourage their curiosity, strengthen their faith, and help them see how deeply they are loved by God.
