A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Church Family,

One of the most formative summers of my life was the summer before my senior year of college. I spent those months serving at JH Ranch in northern California. One afternoon, I remember watching our guys' director, Jason Ellerbee. He was exhausted—physically drained and emotionally spent. Yet instead of complaining, he quietly quoted Isaiah 40:30-31— "Even youths shall faint and be weary... but they who wait for the LORD shall renew their strength."

He probably had no idea how much that moment would impact me. He did more than quote Scripture; he lived it. In a moment of weakness, he pointed everyone around him to the strength of Christ. He modeled what it looks like to respond to adversity with faith, just as Jesus did.

"Let Others See Jesus In You" is more than the title of a beloved hymn. It's a phrase I often repeat to my children because it's a truth I need to remember myself. Every word we speak and every action we take says something about the One we represent. Scripture calls believers "ambassadors for Christ" (2 Corinthians 5:20). We bear His name wherever we go.



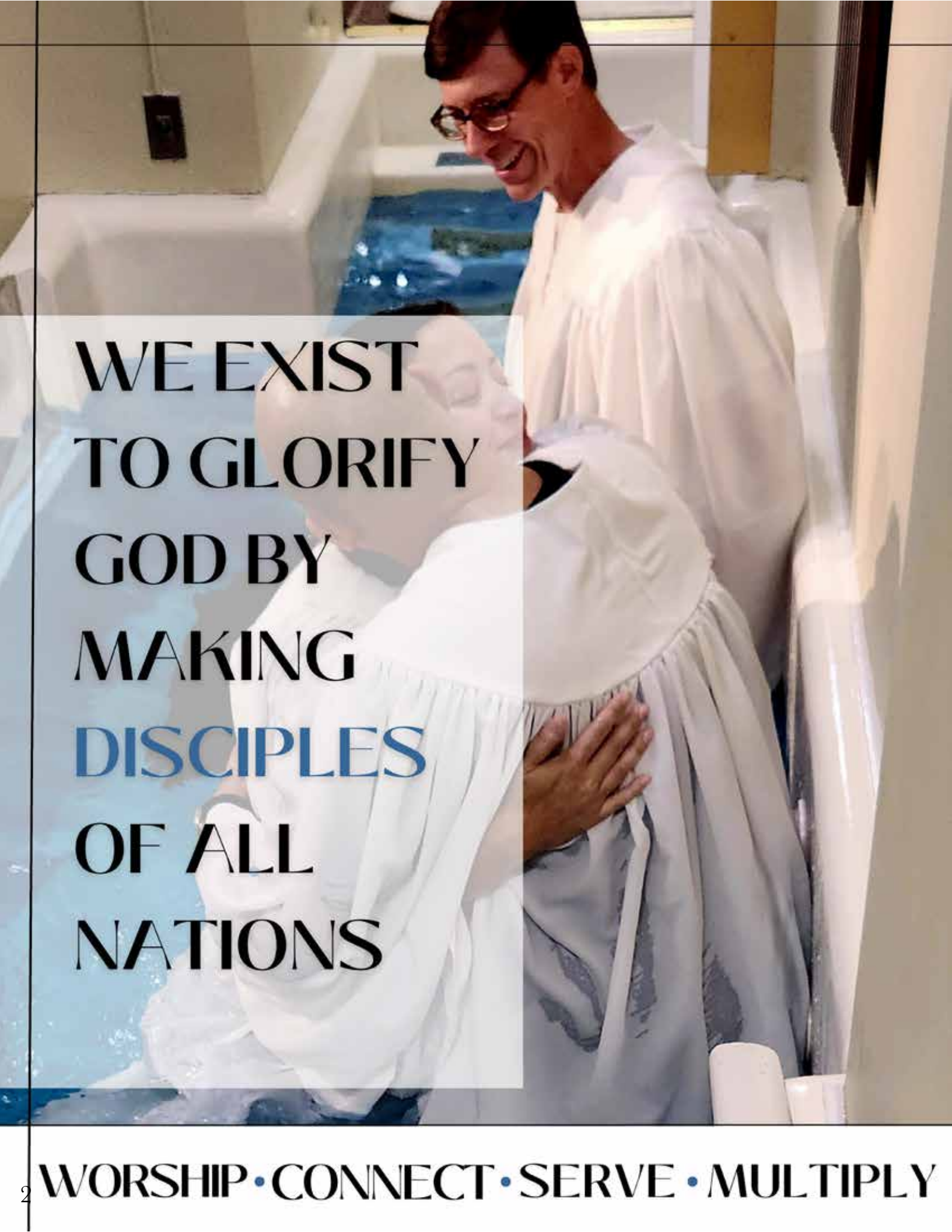
That is why Paul writes, "And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him" (Colossians 3:17).

Centuries ago, one particular Puritan prayed, "May my words and works allure others to the highest walks of faith and love." What a worthy prayer for every Christian.

As we go about our homes, workplaces, schools, and neighborhoods this month, may we remember that someone is always watching. Our words can wound or encourage. Our actions can hinder or help. By God's grace, may our lives consistently point others to Christ.

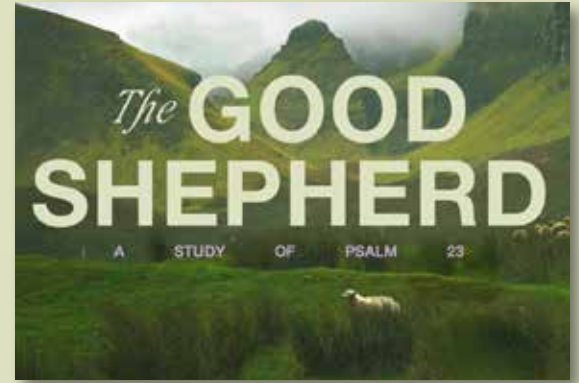
2026 Summer Recap: MFUGE

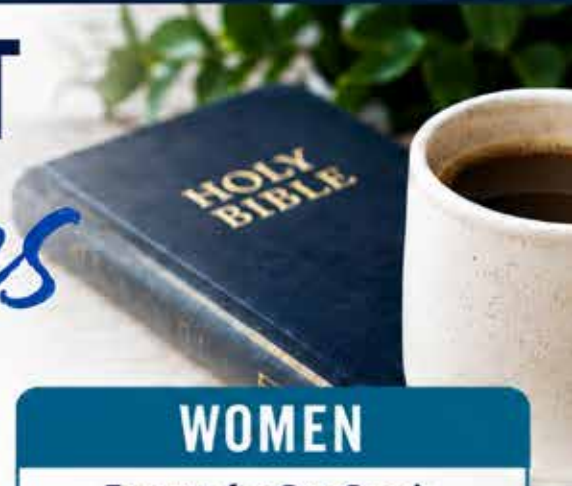

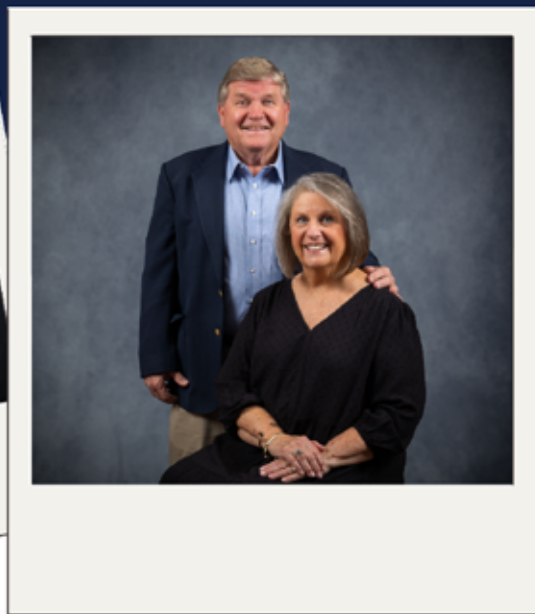
“
