A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Church Family,

May is full. The calendar fills quickly – ball games, graduations, travel, celebrations. These are good gifts from the Lord. But in the busyness, we must take care not to lose sight of the greatest reality in the universe: the love of God displayed at Calvary.

- God's promise to the first Adam: obey and live.
- God's promise to the second Adam (Jesus): obey and be crushed.

And He still obeyed. Why? Because it was the only way He could crush sin without crushing us. "Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us" (Galatians 3:13). On the cross, Jesus stepped into the place of judgment so that we could step into the place of grace. He descended into the depths so that we could be raised to life.

The old hymn writer George Herbert captured it well in his poem, "The Sacrifice."

*O all ye who pass by, behold and see;
Man stole the fruit, but I must climb the tree;
The tree of life to all, but only me:
Was ever grief like mine?*

The cross became the tree of life for us because it was the tree of death for Him. Don't rush past that this month. Pause. Reflect. Worship. Because of the cross, you can hate your sin without hating yourself. Because of the cross, you can face suffering without turning from God. Because of the cross, you are loved—fully, finally, forever. So in the middle of a busy season, slow down long enough to behold the glory of God in the face of Christ.

2026 Honduras Spring Break Mission Trip



Over Spring Break, a team of 11 adults and 11 students went on mission to Honduras, where God moved in powerful ways. We had the opportunity to share the gospel with around 1,000 children in local schools and distributed over 500 pounds of rice and beans while engaging in door-to-door evangelism. It was an incredible week, witnessing God at work both in the hearts of our team and in the lives of the Honduran people. It was such a blessing as our church lived out our mission to "glorify God by making disciples of all nations."



Easter Egg Hunt 2026!

We had a PHENOMENAL time at our annual community Easter Egg Hunt!

We had roughly 500 people attend, with 112 of those being willing volunteers.

The children scrambled to gather 6,000 prize eggs that were strewn across the soccer fields.

We also gave out 350 goodie bags to the attendees. Each bag contained toys, lots of candy, a coloring book of the Easter story, an invitation to our church, and the plan for salvation.

Thanks to everyone who made this event possible!



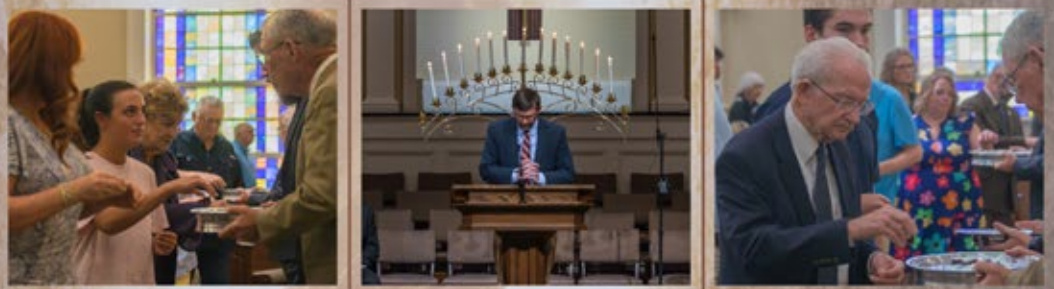

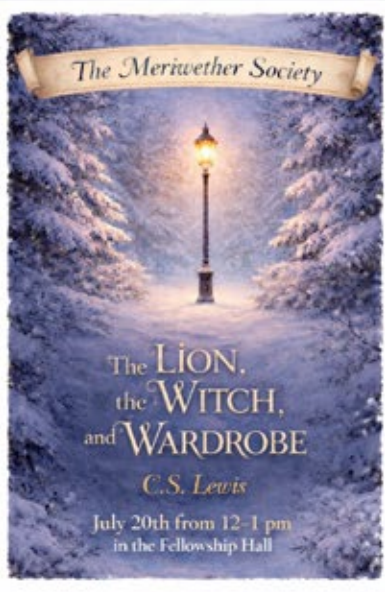

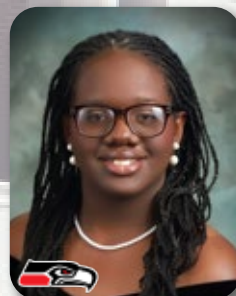

Growing in Mind & Spirit

A deep dive into the spiritual and physical development of our 5-year-olds & 5th graders

Five-year-olds: Kindergarten marks a beautiful season of growth, both physically and spiritually, in the lives of young children. At this age, children are full of energy and curiosity. Their physical development becomes more refined as they gain better coordination, balance, and control of movement. Simple activities like running, drawing, and playing games help strengthen their bodies while also building confidence and independence.

Alongside these physical milestones, kindergarteners are also beginning to develop spiritually in meaningful ways. Their understanding of faith is simple yet sincere. They are naturally open to learning about God's love, kindness, and truth. Bible stories, songs, and prayers introduce them to foundational concepts such as love, forgiveness, and obedience. At this stage, children often express faith through trust—believing what they are taught and showing compassion toward others.

In a church setting, nurturing both physical and spiritual growth is essential. Providing a safe, active environment for play alongside intentional teaching of God's Word helps children grow holistically. Encouraging participation in songs, scripture memory, and simple acts of service lays the groundwork for a lifelong relationship with Christ.

As we guide kindergarteners, we are reminded of Jesus' words to welcome little children. By supporting their development with patience, love, and biblical truth, we help plant seeds that can flourish for years to come.

How can you pray for this class?

Pray for Wednesday night and Sunday morning preschool teachers for the upcoming school year. Pray for leaders to have wisdom as they place teachers in classes.

Fifth graders: Fifth grade is a time of important transition, as children begin moving from childhood toward adolescence. Physically, many are experiencing early stages of puberty, bringing noticeable changes in height, strength, and energy levels. Coordination and endurance often improve, allowing them to excel in sports, music, and other activities. At the same time, these rapid changes can sometimes make them feel self-conscious, highlighting the need for encouragement and reassurance.

Spiritually, fifth graders are beginning to think more deeply about their faith. They move beyond simply accepting what they are taught and start asking questions about what they believe and why. This is a valuable stage for helping them develop a personal understanding of God's Word. They are more capable of grasping biblical truths, memorizing scripture, and applying lessons to their daily lives, including friendships, honesty, and responsibility.

As these young individuals navigate both physical and spiritual changes, the church has a unique opportunity to support and mentor them. With consistent guidance, love, and biblical teaching, fifth graders can continue building a strong foundation for a lasting and meaningful relationship with Christ.

"Find Community and Commit Yourself to Prayer!"

A reflection on motherhood, family discipleship, and the local church with Anna Windham.

Anna and Chas Windham have been married for nine years after meeting on a summer missions project in college. The Windhams have been blessed with four precious little ones - Charlie (7), Abigail (5), Miriam (2), and Levi (6 months).

After marrying in 2017, Anna and Chas moved to Enterprise and began attending FBCE. They fell in love with the church on day one, but it was involvement on Wednesday nights that truly helped them find such a sweet community. From Sunday school classes, Wednesday night studies, and small groups throughout the week, the Windhams have been blessed with such wonderful people to walk through life and raise children with. In January of 2022, Anna was able to see a longtime dream come to fruition through starting Ballet Coram Deo (in the presence of God), the Christ centered classical ballet program at FBCE. Teaching those classes has provided Anna and her daughter Abigail even more connection to those in the Enterprise community. FBCE has been a gift to the Windham family, as it has helped to grow both Anna and Chas' walks with the Lord, and has been a loving community to help walk through the first years of marriage and welcoming multiple children.

As we celebrate Mother's Day on May 10, Anna shares about her time as a mom raising a family in our
22 church.

What advice would you give young parents trying to raise and disciple their children?

The two most important things I believe are to ***find community and commit yourself to prayer!*** Parenting is wonderful and hard, but having a Christ-centered, loving, and encouraging group of like-minded parents to help spur you on in your parenthood journey is truly a game changer. Having people that are going to love your children like their own, while also teaching them the Word of God is an integral part of developing a desire for the things of the Lord in your children.

Also, ***find a community of people that will pray with you and for you.*** Have the accountability of someone who is asking you how your personal prayer life and overall spiritual life are. We can only disciple our kids when we are seeking the Lord ourselves.

How has FBCE helped disciple and point your kids to Jesus?

I cannot say enough wonderful things about the nursery, preschool, and children's ministries of the church.

The devotion and love of those in charge, and their desire to see children come to Christ, is truly unmatched. Whether my kids are in Sunday morning classes, Wednesday night activities, or at Small Steps during the week, I know they are going to be learning about God and singing praises to Him.

Another area of discipleship that has helped point our children to Christ has been through the service opportunities that we as members have at FBCE. My husband and I are a part of the baptism committee at church. On Sundays when we are asked to serve, we help people get ready for their baptisms and clean up afterwards. During those times of service, Chas takes our son, Charlie, with him and those encounters have fostered some wonderful questions and growth in our son.

One of the most beautiful aspects of our church, in my opinion, is the true multi-generational aspect of it. Having believers that are older than you, and that have walked through the same seasons of life can be a resource and blessing for you in your walk through parenting and marriage.
