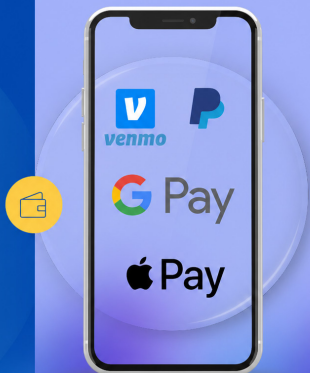
The church received a thank you card from ECTC and EHS,
