II. UNFINISHED DISCUSSION ITEMS

- a. Parking Lot Proposal
 - a. Peter recently sent a congregation-wide email about parking to share upcoming plans, but also to encourage people to take some steps (literally) to help mitigate parking problems.
 - b. Peters Construction is taking our site plans from last time and bringing them out to subcontractors this month to get bids. Since there are relatively few bidders, this is a fairly easy process, and this will give us a good idea of cost. We can always re-bid later.
 - c. Peters Construction is helping us with this pre-construction work at this point. We have yet to decide whether they will be the full general contractor on the project.
 - d. The Stewardship team is working through the project plan and information to share during the annual business meeting.
 - e. Timeline
 - 1. In April, our Shepherding Board will approve a parking lot expansion plan that would add around 100 spots on our east field. This plan will also include two minor projects: a kitchen refresh and an outdoor playground.
 - 2. On April 23rd, our members will vote on this plan at our Annual Business Meeting.
 - 3. If approved, we will move forward with accepting bids and **planning out a** construction timeline.
 - 4. Later this year, we will hold a campaign to raise money for this project and to pay down our current mortgage debt.
 - f. Suggestion was made that we reach out to the neighbors on Orchard Dr across from the Church acknowledge that our on-street parking on Sundays is inconvenient and ask them to be patient as we develop a plan to increase our parking lot.
