Jesus' Healing Miracles

This month, we will be focusing on Jesus's miracles of healing. Have you ever seen the Lord heal someone? Doctors gather around and can't explain what happened, but all the cancer is gone, or the bone is now whole? Share this with your children. If you have never experienced this, ask your small group if they have.

Discuss these questions with your family:

Why do you think Jesus healed these people?
Why do you think He told some of them not to tell anyone?
What other ways can Jesus heal us, besides our physical bodies?
