

Sermon: The Death of Jesus
Scripture: John 19:30

When Jesus had received the sour wine, he said,
“It is finished,” and he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

Reflection Questions:

- In what areas of your life are you still trying to earn God’s love or pay for your own sin?
- What would change about how you treat yourself if you fully believed your debt was paid and not merely reduced?
- Is there a sin you have confessed repeatedly that you have never actually released? How can you allow Christ to bring healing through His work on the cross?
- How does the voluntary nature of Jesus' death change the way you understand your own worth?
- If "it is finished" is true, what would it look like to live tomorrow as someone who is already free?

Guided Prayer:

Thank Jesus for His sacrifice on the cross. Praise Him for fulfilling Scripture and humbling Himself to the point of death. Ask Him to forgive of specific sins that drove Jesus to the cross. Imagine how your sin put Him there. Thank Him for His forgiveness and steadfast grace, and love. Ask Him to live as one who has been set free through Christ. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
