

## **THE COUCH EXPERIENCE CHRISTIAN TRAINING CENTER THE OFFICIAL SANITIZATION LOG**

A Daily Self-Evaluation Tracking Tool for Leadership Integrity & Executive Excellence

### THE PURPOSE OF THE LOG

In a commercial kitchen, physical sanitization prevents contamination, illness, and systemic failure. In ecclesiastical and marketplace leadership, behavioral and ethical sanitization performs the exact same function.

This log is a structured daily tool designed for Change Agents, Marketplace Ambassadors, and Ministry Leaders. It shifts you from a state of emotional reaction to a standard of professional and spiritual excellence. By tracking your internal alignment, you protect your assignment, your family, and the community you serve from the toxic contamination of ego, compromise, and unmanaged stress.

### THE DAILY THREE-STAGE SANITIZATION PROTOCOL

#### STAGE 1: THE MORNING SCRUB (0600 - 0800)

Objective: To wash away the "ego" at the prep table before interacting with staff, clients, or the community.

- Mind-Storage Audit: Am I mentally carrying past grievances, frustrations, or offenses into today's tasks?
  - Clean |  Contaminated (Requires Ego-Washing)
- The Sourcing Check: Is my primary focus today rooted in data integrity, scriptural truth, and service, or am I operating out of a desire for personal validation and visibility?
  - Sourced in Truth |  Sourced in Self-Interest
- Action Directive: Spend 5–10 minutes in silent reflection or prayer, explicitly identifying and laying down any pride, anxiety, or personal agendas before stepping out.

#### STAGE 2: THE MID-DAY INVENTORY & TEMPERATURE CHECK (1200 - 1400)

Objective: To monitor the heat of the station when the pressure of daily operations is at its peak.

- Emotional Temperature Check: Rate your current internal pressure gauge:
  - Cool & Balanced |  Warming (Frustrated/Anxious) |  Boiling (Reactionary/Critical)
- The "Vessel" Inspection: Have your words, emails, or tone toward others deviated from the gentle, peaceable, and gentle service standards of Titus 3:1-8?
  - Maintained 5-Star Standard |  Minor Contamination Detected
- Corrective Action Taken: If warming or contaminated, step away for a 2-minute "station reset" to re-stabilize your EQ (Emotional Intelligence).

#### STAGE 3: THE EVENING SHIFT-CLOSE (2000 - 2200)

Objective: To clean the "Back Kitchen" of your character so that no residue of the day's

stress rots overnight.

- The Clean-Up Review: Did I resolve conflicts quickly today, or did I leave an unresolved issue to simmer with a colleague, family member, or client?
  - All Stations Cleared |  Leftovers Remaining (Requires Reconciliation)
- Stewardship Assessment: Did I manage my time, physical health, environment, and resources (including technology and transportation) with active discipline today?
  - Kept in Good Order |  Neglected (Requires Realignment)
