1 Peter - Part 3 TESTED BY FIRE The Place and Purpose of Trials (1 Peter 1:6-9)

INTRODUCTION:

THE LARGER CONTEXT:

- 1. Our Shared Status: (v. 1-2)
 - "To those who are elect exiles of the Dispersion..." (ESV)
 - We are, at one and the same time, the most <u>disconnected</u> (exiles) and the most <u>connected</u> (elect) people on earth.
- 2. Our **Future Hope**: (v. 3-5)
 - "...to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven,..."
 - The <u>Inheritance</u> and the <u>Inheritor</u> are both secure. And this eschatological <u>hope</u> which is grounded in the <u>resurrection</u> of Jesus Christ is more than sufficient reason to <u>rejoice!</u>
- 3. Our Current Trials: (v. 6-9)
 - "...though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials,..."
