Presets are an amazing tool to easily level up your photography and editing skills. Here's some highlights:

- These presets are versatile on both indoor + outdoor photos and work consistently all types of photography.
- Use these on photos of worship, portraits, lobby, greeting teams or on stage whether dark tones or light tones.

How To Adjust Photos

These presets are made without white balance or exposure settings since every photo is different. After you apply your preset, follow these quick tips.

1) Original (Before)



2) Apply Preset



3) Adjust Exposure



Photo may appear too bright or too dark, adjust the exposure.

4) Adjust Color (After)



Warm up your photo with the temp slider. Tip: for dark indoor photos with colorful lights adjust the tint.

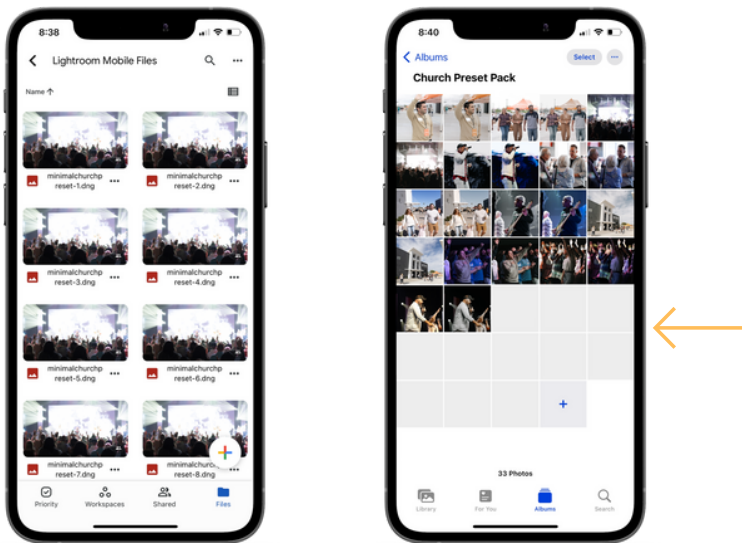

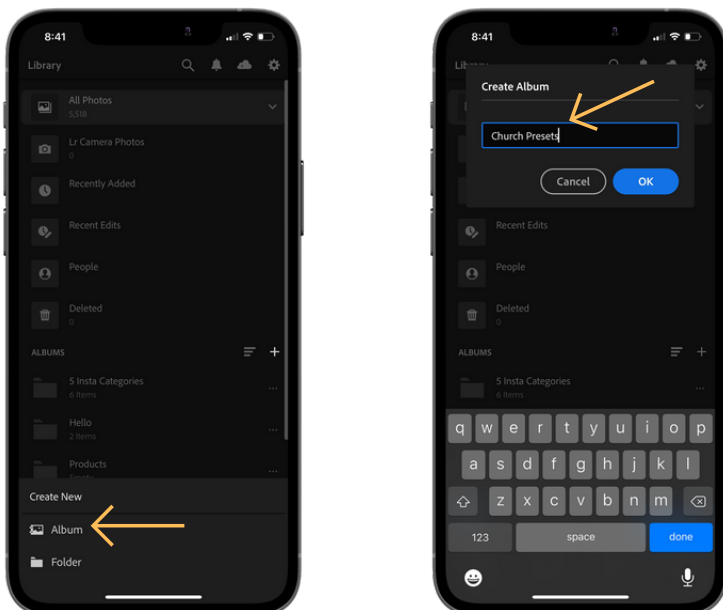

How to Install on Lightroom Mobile

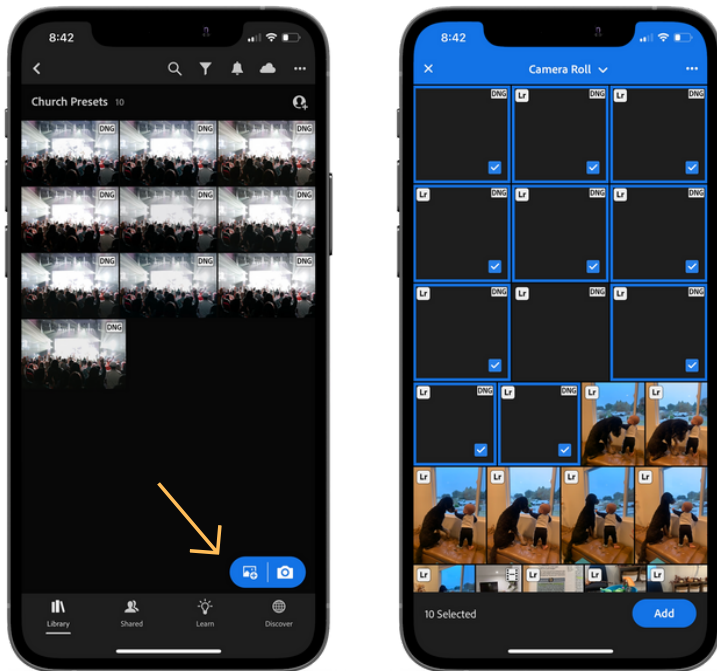
Step 1: Save all .dng files onto your camera roll from google drive. You will see them show up as gray boxes.



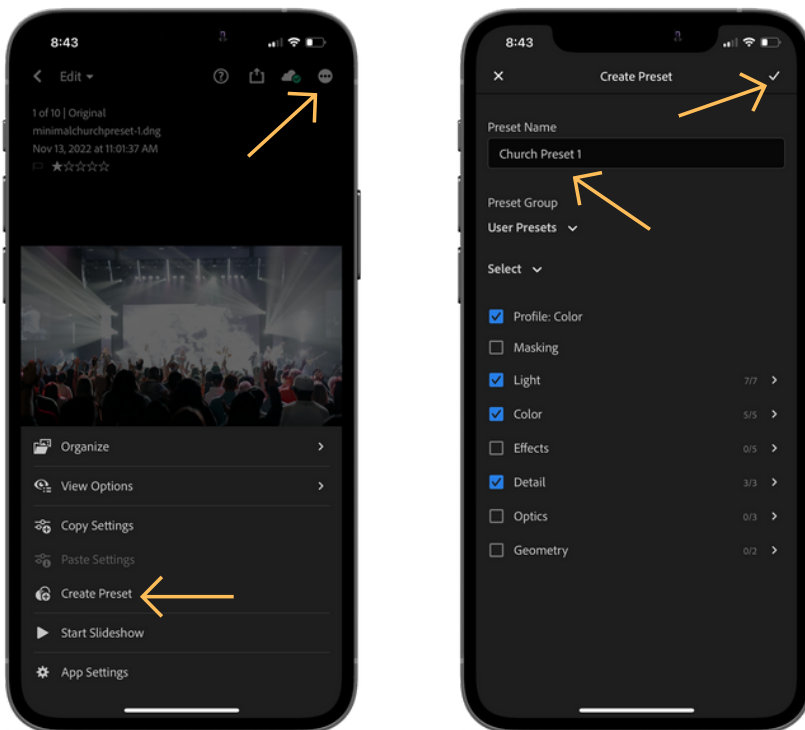
Step 2: Open the Lightroom Mobile App and create an album to stay organized.



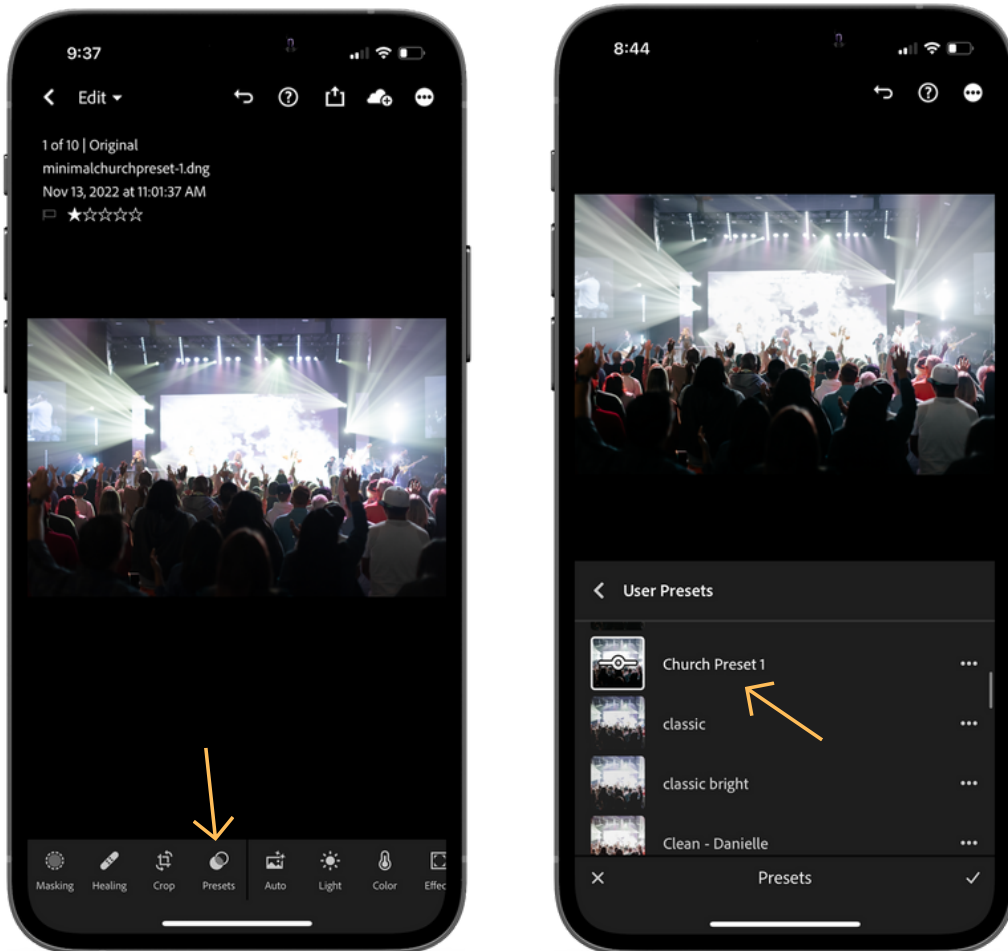
Step 3: Import your .dng files from your camera roll into Lightroom by selecting the add from camera roll button.



Step 4: Next, save the presets to your Lightroom Presets. Open the first .dng file > Select the 3 dots in the top right corner > Select Create Preset. Give it a name and leave the rest of the settings as-is > Repeat for the rest of the .dng files.



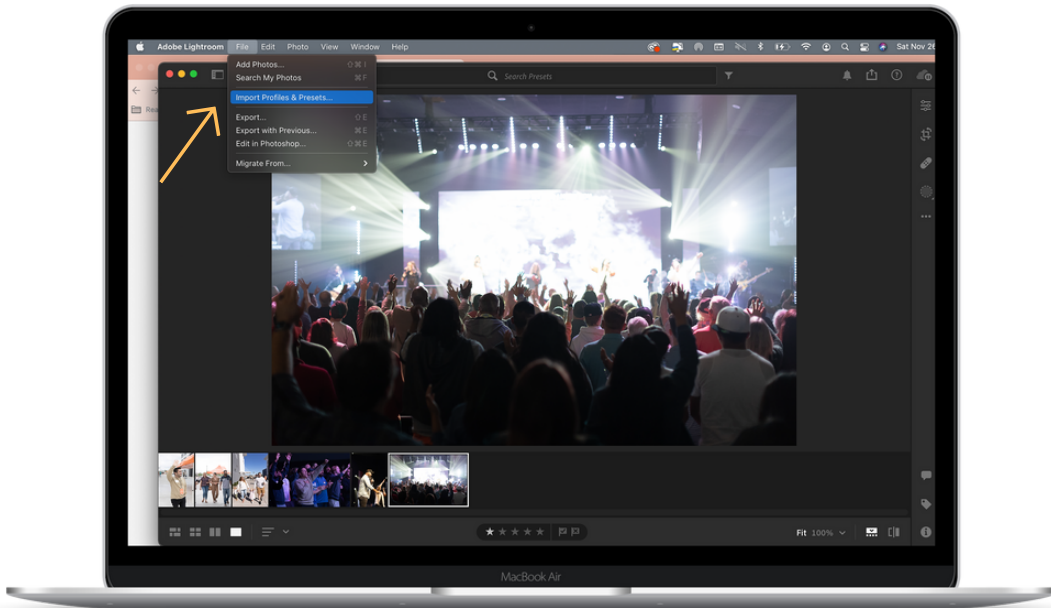
Step 5: Finally, go to the photo you want to edit, tap Presets in the editing panel. Pick a Preset and make any additional adjustments you'd like.



Tip: Hold down on your image with your finger to see the "before" and let go to see the adjustments from the Preset.

How to Install on Lightroom Desktop

Step 1: Open light room and tap File > Import Profiles and Presets. Select your .xmp files.



Step 2: Tap "Presets" and navigate to the "Yours" column to find your new preset pack.
