Children’s Encounter (Sunday School) began last Sunday
with two teachers and two students ages 6 and 3, and was
being offered again this morning in the children’s room on
the second floor. Curriculum is aimed at ages 3-8, but nine

at 9:00 am and pick them up at 10:00 am. **Still needed:**
We need two more adult volunteers to teach or help with
Children’s Encounter on Sunday mornings. Having eight
volunteers means a once-a-month commitment for each

teacher (runs the lesson plan) or as a helper (assists the
teacher.)

The **Children’s Church program** continues as an
option. Parents bring their children into the worship service
with them. After the offering, Miss Vickie and Miss Beth will
lead the children to the first floor classroom for story, song,
prayer, and fun. Children will be returned to their parents in
the sanctuary before communion. Parents always have the
option of keeping their children with them in the sanctuary:
