Romans 8:35–39

Opening Scripture

“No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.” – Romans 8:37

Icebreaker

- 1 What's something you hate losing at?
- 2 Why do you think we naturally want to win?

Key Idea

Victory based on our ability will always have limits. We are more than conquerors through Christ, not through ourselves.

Discussion Questions

- 1 Before this message, what did you think “more than a conqueror” meant? How is that different from what Romans 8:37 teaches?
- 2 Where in your life do you feel strong right now? Where do you feel outmatched?
- 3 How does the Michael Jordan illustration challenge the idea that trying harder is the answer?
- 4 Why is the phrase “through Him who loved us” so important?
- 5 What does it look like to rely on Christ instead of yourself in everyday life?
- 6 Which struggles from Romans 8:35 do you relate to most?
- 7 How does knowing you are already victorious in Christ change how you face those situations?
- 8 Which have you experienced most: God's prevention, intervention, or redemption?
- 9 What has God done in your life that convinces you of His love or faithfulness?

Application

- 1 What is one area where you need to stop relying on your own ability?
- 2 What would it look like this week to trust that you are already victorious in Christ?

- 2 Surrender areas of self-reliance

- 3 Ask for faith to trust Him in current struggles
