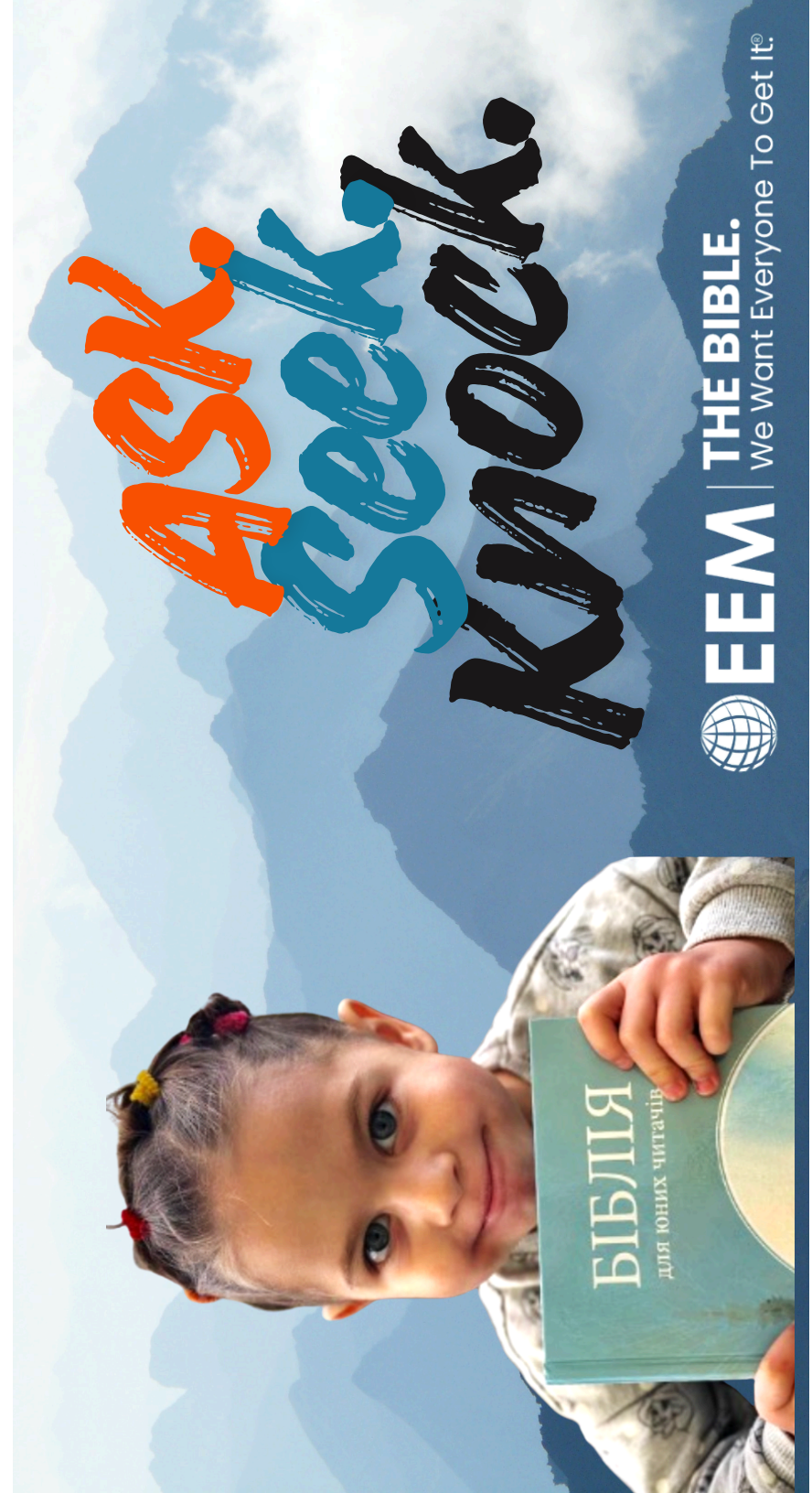

A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

The week after Easter often feels quiet. Family gatherings yielded many new memories, the sound of children hunting eggs has faded, and the hollow chocolate bunnies have all been eaten. Life has begun to return to its usual rhythm. Yet it is now that the reality of a Risen Lord begins to deepen. After all, Jesus' resurrection is more than just a moment to celebrate—it is a reality to live.

In the days after the resurrection, the disciples were not instantly bold or fearless. They were uncertain, processing, even doubting. And still, Jesus met them there—in locked rooms, along ordinary roads, beside familiar waters. He did not rush them past their questions; He stepped into their everyday lives and revealed His presence. Praise be, He extends the same invitation to us.

The week after Easter reminds one that faith in a Risen Lord is more than something to celebrate once a year. Faith is greater than a single powerful moment. It is a demonstration of one's belief, trust, and obedience, not just at church, but in the ordinary spaces— at home, at work, among friends or strangers, to the glory of our Lord and Savior, filling one with heavenly hope.

So, this week, instead of asking how to hold on to the feeling of Easter, consider how to walk in the empowerment of its truth. Share the good news of Jesus Christ with another. Tell them of the forgiveness and reconciliation Jesus offers to those who believe. Encourage others to live confidently in the hope and assurance made possible by Jesus Christ. Luke 24:46-48.
