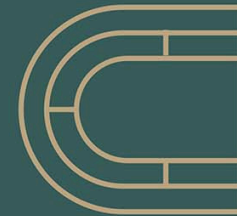

### SCRIPT 1: INVITE TO YOUR LOCAL PRAYER EVENT

Hi Everyone,

## A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

In many organizations, 20% of the people do 80% of the work. But here at CK, it is reversed. Almost everyone is involved in some way - whether leading, teaching, or participating in a Life Group, a ministry, or a service team. Or they spontaneously help in a myriad of other ways that most of us will never even know. Our people love to be together, and it shows. Young and old alike are enjoying and thriving in this fellowship for which we, your shepherds, are thankful beyond words. As your shepherds, we have no greater hope than to leave this as a legacy – not only that the congregation thrived while we had the oversight, but also that it continue to do so long after we are gone.

As such, the teaching of the apostle Peter is helpful. He told his congregation (those who had "received a faith as precious as ours" (2Pe 1:1)), how to keep it going. In 2Pe 1:5-7 he exhorted them (and us) to "make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love."

It is possible to lose what we have. Just consider what happened to Judas. That must not be allowed to happen here – not to you, nor any of us! In short, every one of us needs to "make every effort" to grow. Complacency will destroy a church. But Peter said that growing in these qualities will "keep you from being ineffective and unproductive..." (2Pe 1:8)

"Therefore...be all the more eager to make your calling and election sure. For if you do these things, you will never fall, and you will receive a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ." (2Pe 1:10-11)
