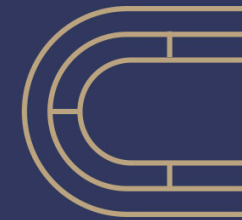

A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

The story is told how, many years ago, a military commander received a vision, which opened the way for multitudes to come to faith in Jesus. This commander was in the habit of giving to those in need and praying regularly to God. You can read about this remarkable man, named Cornelius, in Acts chapter 10.

In a similar way, our own prayers and good deeds are not without effect. As a congregation, we prayed for the unborn and their mothers throughout the entire year in 2021 - and in 2022, the infamous Supreme Court decision known as Roe vs Wade was overturned. Later that year, we asked the congregation to give us their prayer requests, which we categorized and prayed for as a congregation. The largest category was to expand our outreach and we were subsequently blessed with the formation of a new prayer team as well as the ability to hire a new youth-and-outreach minister. Today our congregation is blessed with a vibrant and growing fellowship in answer to our prayers.

The angel in Cornelius' vision greeted him with these words, "Cornelius!...Your prayers and gifts to the poor have come up as a memorial offering before God..." (Acts 10:3-4). I doubt Cornelius thought about it at the time he was giving and praying, but the story clearly reveals that heaven was paying very close attention. And you also can be sure the Lord loves you and will not forget your prayers and good works either.

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." Phil 4:6-7)
